#### **EVENTS AT HPUBS**

#### **HPUBS INDUCTION 2025: INSPIRING THE NEXT GENERATION**

Himachal Pradesh University Business School (HPUBS) conducted a structured orientation for the MBA 2025–27 batch from **28th July to 2nd August 2025**, concluding with a special lecture on 6th August. ## SIDDHARTH CHAUHAN: A VISIONARY FILMMAKER AND PROUD HPUBS ALUMNUS



**Siddharth Chauhan,** an alumnus of HPUBS (MBA – Marketing & HR, Batch 2008–11), has emerged as one of India's most promising independent filmmakers. Known for his compelling storytelling and artistic originality, Siddharth continues to inspire audiences and young creators alike.

With over a decade of experience, Siddharth has mentored students at premier institutes like FTII, SRFTI, NIFT, NIT, and Whistling Woods International, and has served as a jury member for various national-level drama and filmmaking competitions.

His debut feature film "Amar Colony" premiered at the Tallinn Black Nights Film Festival (POFF 2022)—a BAFTA and Academy qualifying event—winning the Jury Prize for Originality of Vision, making him the first Indian director to receive this honor. The film later earned him the Best Indian Debut Director Award at the International Film Festival of Kerala (IFFK 2022) and a nomination for the FIPRESCI India Grand Prix.

Siddharth's earlier short film "Papa" won the Satyajit Ray Award at the London Indian Film Festival (LIFF). His films have been showcased on global OTT platforms like MUBI and Shorts TV.

Recognized for his distinct voice, he was chosen by the NFDC Co-Production Market (2018) to represent Himachal Pradesh, a first for any filmmaker from the state. He has also contributed as a casting director, screenwriter, cinematographer, editor, and producer, discovering fresh talent like Mohit Parmar, Shubham Dipta, and Richa Rathore.

A proud son of Shimla's Nawar Valley, Siddharth continues to nurture local talent through workshops and mentorship programs, while his films beautifully portray the evolving stories, identities, and culture of Himachal Pradesh.

# KIRAN MAZUMDAR SHAW: BREWING BIOTECH DREAMS INTO REALITY



Kiran Mazumdar-Shaw, one of India's most influential entrepreneurs, founded Biocon in 1978 in Bangalore, starting operations from a small garage with minimal capital. At a time when India's industrial focus revolved around manufacturing and information technology, she identified biotechnology as an untapped field capable of addressing global healthcare challenges. With a background in fermentation science and a determination to merge scientific innovation with enterprise, she entered an industry that was largely unknown in India. Despite facing significant hurdles such as lack of funding, limited infrastructure, and gender bias, Mazumdar-Shaw remained resolute in her vision of establishing a researchdriven company capable of producing affordable, high-quality biopharmaceutical products. Her determination and strategic foresight laid the groundwork for what would become one of India's leading biotechnology companies.

In its early years, Biocon focused on the production of industrial enzymes for international markets, particularly in Europe and the United States. This gave the company early global recognition and valuable experience in maintaining international quality standards. As the company matured, Biocon shifted from enzyme manufacturing to more complex biopharmaceutical products, including insulin, biosimilars, and cancer therapies. This transition marked a turning point, establishing Biocon as a research-oriented organization committed to innovation and public health. Under Mazumdar-Shaw's leadership, Biocon invested heavily in R&D, building world-class laboratories and manufacturing facilities that met stringent global regulatory norms. These efforts enabled the company to compete internationally, collaborate with global pharmaceutical giants, and expand access to affordable treatments for millions of patients, particularly in developing countries.

Mazumdar-Shaw's leadership style combined scientific rigor with strong ethical values and a deep sense of social responsibility. She maintained that scientific progress should directly benefit society, emphasizing that innovation in healthcare must prioritize affordability and accessibility over profit. Her vision redefined the role of business in biotechnology, proving that commercial success and social impact can coexist. Under her guidance, Biocon developed a culture rooted in transparency, sustainability, and continuous learning, enabling it to uphold international standards while remaining grounded in ethical practices. She also championed gender equality and the inclusion of women in science and leadership, encouraging more women to pursue careers in research and management. Through her initiatives, Biocon became not only a company but also a symbol of India's growing capabilities in cutting-edge biomedical innovation. Her commitment to responsible entrepreneurship earned her global recognition and numerous awards, reinforcing her position as a thought leader in biotechnology. Today, Biocon stands as a multibillion-dollar enterprise with a strong international presence, and its success has inspired a new generation of entrepreneurs to pursue innovation-driven ventures. Kiran Mazumdar-Shaw's journey from a modest garage startup to a global biopharmaceutical powerhouse symbolizes resilience, foresight, and the transformative potential of science-led enterprise in shaping a better world.
