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Providing hands-on experience that can go beyond the theoretical knowledge and develop skills essential for becoming an effective professional is the need of the hour. For realizing the goals of a successful career, skill enhancement of and integration of skill-focused activities is important. Practical experience must be given emphasis to employability skills. Students should master the professional skills required by employers. Keeping in view the need of the hour, a seven-day virtual workshop was organized by the Department of Interdisciplinary Studies, Himachal Pradesh University in collaboration with Himachal Pradesh State Pollution Control Board from 26th August to 1st September, 2021.

As many as 53 students of M.Sc. Environmental Sciences participated in this workshop. The main purpose of this workshop was to make students aware of the mandate, objectives, activities and jurisdiction of HPSPCB; water testing (covering all possible parameters, including sampling, preservation, testing, etc.); monitoring of Ambient Air Quality, noise pollution, handling of Bio-medical Waste and guiding them about the regulatory framework linked with air & water pollution, solid waste and biomedical waste generation.

The workshop was inaugurated by Prof Sikander Kumar, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of Himachal Pradesh University. During his inaugural address, Prof Sikander emphasized on the need of becoming scientific professionals and the skill development for the same. He was of the view that in order to realize the goals of a successful career one has to master the professional skills. This was followed by the address of the Director, Prof Parkash Chandel.

The Senior Scientific Officers and team of laboratory professionals of Regional Laboratory of HPSPCB, through their demonstrations and interactions trained the students on various aspects of monitoring and combating environmental

pollution. Each day session was followed by the online test, which consisted of multiple choice questions. It was mandatory for the students to appear in the test. The students on completion of tests were given certificates.
