# *One Day National Seminar on Indian Science*

## *Organised by the University institute of Information Technology in association*

The impression that science started only in Europe was deeply embedded in the minds of educated people all over the world. But, there was very little reference to India. Thanks to the investigation made by the Indian National Science Academy and some of the other Science and Technology Institutions, for revealing that India had consistently been a scientific country right from Vedic to modern times, having knowledge of Algebra, Calculus, Geometry, Astronomy, concept of Space and Time, Ayurveda, Metallurgy, Agriculture, Environment etc. In fact, we do not find an example of a civilization, except perhaps that of ancient Greece, which accorded the same place to knowledge and science as India had. But, there was also a bad patch when ancient Indian Universities, which were the temples of universal knowledge, were destroyed by foreign invaders, propelling India into a Dark Age of Ignorance.

The introduction of western science in India is very recent. During the entire period of British rule, the rulers were most reluctant to have Indians in the top echelon of any activity. Study of liberal arts and languages were allowed while technical subjects like the sciences and engineering were not encouraged. Even in this atmosphere, there were some bright Indians who realized the importance of science and scientific investigations. And thereby, European literature on science, industry, technology and various forms of research equipment slowly paved its way into our country. In the post-independence era, government initiated the process of nation building through the establishment of various institute of science and technology. Within a short period, India became a self-reliant nation in term of nuclear energy, space technology and other spheres of R & D.

But, this revival was not an easy task to accomplish and many Indian scientists devoted their entire lives, to place India in the list of top ranked nations in the field of Scientific and technical development. This particular one day national seminar is aimed to acknowledge and celebrate the glorious contribution of some of these Indian Scientists in making India a leading Nation in science and technology and to spread a wave of inspiration in the minds of budding scientists and engineers.

The seminar was held on 22-09-2018 at the UIIT Conference Hall. Dr. Shyam Chand, Asstt. Prof. (Applied Physics) was the Organising Chair from UIIT, H. P. University Shimla and Prof. (Mrs.) Neeraj Sharma was Convener of the seminar from ISCA-Shimla Chapter. The commencement of seminar took place with the arrival of Chief Guest Prof. Arvind Kalia, Dean of Studies H. P. University Shimla at 10:00 AM, who was escorted by Convener of the seminar from ISCA-Shimla Chapter Prof. (Mrs.) Neeraj Sharma and Director UIIT. The conference hall was full to its capacity and a gathering of about 170 participants which includes students of UIIT, students and their respected teachers from GSSS Boileugaunj, Faculty members and staff of UIIT, Faculty members from various Departments of H. P. University, former Directors of UIIT and Invited Speakers.

The seminar began with an Introductory Speech by Organising Chair Dr. Shyam Chand followed by Lighting of Lamp to pay tribute to Maa-Saraswati-Goddess of knowledge. Thereafter, Director UIIT Prof. P. L. Sharma felicitated the Chief Guest and Guests of honour with memento. He also presented a welcome speech. Then Prof. (Mrs.) Neeraj Sharma introduced ISCA-Shimla Chapter and its contribution in organizing such events. The first technical event of the seminar took place at 10.30 AM wherein a movie/documentary "Quantum Indians" was played by Prof. P. K. Ahluwalia. The documentary portrays lives of three renowned Indian scientists - C. V. Raman, Meghnad Saha and S. N. Bose, with their remarkable contribution in the field of science and technology. The movie was highly motivating and liked by everyone in the hall. At the end of movie, Prof. P. K. Ahluwalia quizzed the participants with questions based on the movie. The participants who gave the correct answers were presented with chocolates. Further, Prof. P. K. Ahluwalia was invited to present his talk on "Respected Master: Albert Einstein" and talk covered some interesting chapters of life of Albert Einstein, one of the greatest scientist, philosopher, thinker and above all a great saintly soul on this earth, from early school days to the end of his life.

Post lunch session began at 2:00 PM and Prof. Mahavir Singh was invited to deliver his lecture. The title of the lecture was "Future of Nanotechnology in Engineering Sector". The participants were given a brief introduction of the term Nano and Nanotechnology in a very simple language. Prof. Mahavir emphasized that Nanotechnology is not a branch specific to any particular branch of science but it embraces all the branches of fundamental sciences, engineering, medical sciences, computer science, social sciences etc. He gave the idea how the magnetic nanoparticles can be helpful in the fields of Spintronics and in Medical science for the treatment of cancer and in water purification. The topics covered were highly motivating and participant took keen interest in the lecture.
