Item: To discuss modifications in the pattern of question papers of various courses and structure of courses offered in Journalism and Mass Communication to under graduate (UG) students of Himachal Pradesh University in light of the recommendations of Deans of the Faculties of Himachal Pradesh University in their emergent meeting held on 27th August 2015.

Decision: The members noted that several courses offered in Journalism and Mass Communication to UG students had five units whereas the pattern no. 2 suggested in the meetings of Deans assumes four units per course (Item 1 of Annexure a). Besides, there are several courses with practical content. In light of this discrepancy and the emergent nature of the matter (keeping in view the forthcoming end-semester examinations) the UG BoS authorized the Departmental Council to make necessary structural changes to the courses as per administrative needs of the University. The authorization to Departmental Council relates to distribution of marks, pattern of question paper for end-semester examinations, internal re-arrangements of units and their contents. However, in case of any addition/deletion of either courses of study, course contents of individual courses or recommended reading lists, the matter shall have to be approved by the BoS.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
