Decision: The Chairman of the Board of Studies (BoS) in Journalism and Mass Communication (undergraduate courses) placed before the members the recommendations of the meeting of the Deans/Chairpersons/Directors of the dated 13 June 2018 for switching over from CBCS Semester

system to CBCS Annual system. The members of the BoS amended the programme structure from semester to yearly format with a requirement of 132 credits for B.A. (Pass) degree programme and 148 credits for B.A. (Honours) degree programme for students of Journalism and Mass Communication.
