At the outset, the Chairman of the Committee welcomed all the members of the Committee. The member convenor placed the item/record of H.P. Science & Technology Entrepreneurs Park (HPSTEP) before the Committee for its perusal, examination and recommendations.

The Committee perused the agenda item alongwith its enclosures, the record of the H.P. STEP and decision of the Executive Council taken vide Item No. 16 in its meeting held on 31.1.2012 notified vide Notification No. 9-31/2002-HPU(Genl.) dated 18.2.2012. The Committee observed that the staff of the H.P. Science & Technology Entrepreneurs Park (HP STEP), an undertaking of the State Government temporarily established in the University, was merged and deployed in the University in the following offices/branches as per their designation vide office order No. 9-5/58-HPU(Estt.) dated 24.2.2012. Accordingly, the officials joined their duties in the respective offices/branches w.e.f. the date(s) mentioned against each:-

The Committee observed that while merger of their services in the main establishment of the University, since there was no budgetary provision in the budget provision of the H.P. University for payment of their salary, pension and other recurring expenditures, the same were being met out of the annual grant/funds being provided by the State Government for H.P. Science & Technology Entrepreneurs Park (HPSTEP), in before although, the staff of the HP STEP was merged in the main stream of the

University yet was not granted seniority in the respective cadres of the main University and were kept ex-cadre.

The Committee further observed that the University in compliance of the decision of the Executive Council taken vide Item No. 16 in its meeting held on 31.1.2012 notified vide Notification No. 9-31/2002-HPU(Genl.) dated 18.2.2012 had taken up the matter with the State Government to provide grant-in-aid to bear the expenses of salary, pension and other recurring expenditures in respect of the merged staff of H.P. Science & Technology Entrepreneurs Park (HPSTEP) in the main stream of the University. The State Government vide letter No. EDN-A-Ga(10)-2/2011-Loose dated 11.9.2013 intimated the University that the matter was examined in consultation with the Finance Department of the Government and advised to bear the expenses of salary, pension and other recurring expenditures of the staff of H.P. Science & Technology Entrepreneurs Park (HPSTEP) from the budgetary provisions of the University provided for the current financial year to the University by the State Government. The University however, again took up the matter with the State Government to provide extra grant but the Government vide letter No. EDN-A-Ga(10)-2/2011-Loose dated 22.8.2014 advised this University to take further action in accordance with its earlier dated 11.9.2013.

The advice/communication so received from the State Government vide letter dated 11.9.2012 and 22.8.2014 was again placed before the Executive Council for consideration and such decision as it may deem fit in the light of its earlier decision notified vide Notification No. 9-31/2002-HPU(Genl.) dated 18.2.2012.

The Executive Council vide Item No. 7 in its meeting held on 29.4.2015 has taken following decision with regard to HP STEP notified vide Notification No. 9-31/2002-HPU(Genl.) dated 27.8.2015 :-


The Committee also perused the decision of the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. given in CWP No. 9945/2014 titled as K.G. Thakur Versus state of H.P. & others and found that though there is no dispute with regard to merger of the staff of H.P. STEP in the main stream of the University however, their claim to enroll them as General Provident Subscriber under old pension scheme w.e.f. the date of their merger i.e. 24.2.2012 is not acceptable in the light of Notification dated 28.11.2006 issued by the State Government with regard to New Contributory Pension Scheme in place of old pension scheme applicable w.e.f. 15.5.2003 which has also been adopted by the University. The Hon'ble High Court has dismissed/declined


the claim of the Petitioners to grant G.P.F. Number under old pension scheme.


The Committee after having detailed deliberations on all the issues/facts, representations given by the staff of the H.P. STEP with regard to grant them seniority in the respective cadres of the main University w.e.f. 24.2.2012 made the following recommendations :-


1. That while merger of their services w.e.f. 24.2.2012 in the main establishment of the University in pursuance of the decision taken by the Executive Council vide Item No. 16 in its meeting held on 31.1.2012 notified vide Notification No. 9-31/2002-HPU(Genl.) dated 18.2.2012, since there was no budgetary provision in the budget provision of the H.P. University for payment of their salary, pension and other recurring expenditures and the same on advice of the State Government were approved by the Executive Council vide Item No. 7 of its meeting held on 29.4.2015, therefore, in the eventuality of grant of seniority in the respective cadres of the main University w.e.f. 24.2.2012, as contended by the incumbent concerned, will be in violation of the decisions of the Executive Council dated 31.1.2012 & 29.4.2015.
2. That since the budgetary provisions to meet the expenditure on account of salary, pension and other recurring expenses were approved by the Executive Council vide Item No. 7 of its meeting held on 29.4.2015, therefore, to grant them seniority in the respective cadres with immediate effect at the bottom of the respective cadres will also not be legally justified and will be disadvantageous to the incumbents.
3. Therefore, the Committee was of the unanimous view and recommended that the incumbents may be considered for grant of seniority in the respective cadre w.e.f. 27.8.2015 i.e. the date of notification of the decision taken by the Executive Council in its meeting held on 29.4.2015 notified vide Notification dated 27.8.2015 with regard to budgetary provisions to meet the expenditure of Salary, Pension & other expenses of the staff of H.P. Science & Technology Entrepreneurs Park (HP STEP) merged in the main stream of the University.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

in which the student applies for admission.

- (e) In these subjects the student shall be required to accumulate a certain minimum number of credits in order to qualify for the U.G degree.
- (f) A student who has opted for a bachelor's degree will have the option available to him/her of converting the degree to a major (honours) degree. This will be done by accumulating 56 or more credits in one of the subjects chosen within a period of five years from the date of enrolment into the programme.

→ 7.4: The following provision related to guidelines for the degree under CBCS shall be added :

For the Degree:

- (a) A regular candidate shall have to undergo the prescribed courses of study in a College affiliated to the H.P. University for a period not less than three academic years (and not more than five academic years), and should have passed the examinations prescribed and fulfilled such conditions as have been prescribed thereof.
- (b) The Himachali candidates belonging to the SC and ST categories and women candidates from Himachal Pradesh shall be allowed to enroll with ICDEOL for the UG Programme by paying a fee of Rs. 500 as ICDEOL registration fee and a fee of Rs 500 for the hard copy course material. Such candidates shall be the students of ICDEOL for all purposes.
- (c) There shall be no private or other category of students and they shall be eligible for the degree either through regular mode or through distance education mode.
- (d) Candidates other than the regular candidates shall have to undergo the prescribed courses of study from the International Centre for Distance Education and Open Learning (ICDEOL) H.P. University for a period not less than three academic years (and not more than five academic years) passed the examinations prescribed and fulfilled such conditions as have been prescribed thereof.
- (e) For the degree (B.A. / B. Sc. / B.Com. /B.C.A / B.B.A./B.E./B.P. Shastri) the student will have to cumulate a minimum of 120 successful credit hours of coursework for a bachelor's degree with honours, or 106 successful credit hours of coursework for a bachelor's degree over a minimum of three and a maximum of five years from the date of admission. (notified on 02.09.15 academic session 2015-16)
- (f) The candidate shall not be allowed more than three attempts to pass a course.

7.5: Duration (Time Frame)

- (a) The UG (TDC) programme for a regular student shall be for a minimum period of three years and a maximum of five years from the date of admission of the candidate. Each academic session shall be for a period of one year.

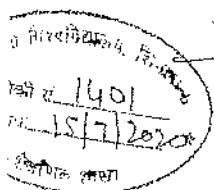





University Institute of Technology (UIT) is a premier institute of Himachal Pradesh University, running B. Tech. Programme in five (05) branches of Engineering and Technology (IT, CSE, ECE, CE, EE), all of which are duly approved by AICTE. Till 2018, there were only two (02) branches, i.e. IT and CSE, but three (03) new branches (ECE, CE, EE) were introduced since the year 2019 besides IT and CSE.

Further, UIT has adopted new system of awarding certificates/grade cards to the students with 2019-2020 batch and onwards, based on Absolute Grading system for all B. Tech. Programmes. The new schemes and syllabi of B. Tech. (IT/CSE/ECE/CE/EE) - Year I&II semesters have already been approved by competent bodies of HPU.

In addition to this, UIT wishes to propose a provision to award B. Tech. (Honours) degree to the candidates, who are ambitious to take up extra courses of Emerging Technologies in their own branch or other branches, to enhance their skills and specialising in those fields.

Of the following, the content from serial no. 1-3 has already been approved by the different academic bodies of HPU. But the content from serial no. 4-6 has been proposed by the Departmental Council of UIT for the discussion, deliberation and approval in Board of Studies.

1. Grading System (Already Approved)

University Institute of Technology (UIT) shall adopt absolute grading system for all the B. Tech. courses from the batch 2019-2023 and onwards. The overall performance of a student in any course shall be awarded with a Letter Grade in each course he/she is registered for, indicating his/her overall Academic Performance. There are eight letter grades: O, A, B, C, D, E and F and R. The correspondence between Letter Grades, Grade Point (in a 10-point scale), Percentage Marks and Academic Performance is given below:

1.1 General Instructions to award the grades:

- i) All evaluations of different components of a course announced in the Course Plan shall be done in terms of marks for each student.
- ii) The marks of various components of a paper shall be added to get total marks secured on a 100-point scale.
[Note: Practical papers are normally already on 100 point scale (External = 50, Internal Assessment = 50); but the scores of theory papers need to be changed. For example, if a candidate's total scores in a paper is 114 marks out of 150 marks (External = 100, Internal Assessment = 50), then the score of the candidate in this paper on 100 point scale will be $114 \times 100 / 150 = 76$]
- iii) For any course, the above table will be used to award grades corresponding to the secured marks in each paper.
- iv) A student, who does not appear in the End Semester Examination for any reason or scores less than 40% marks in End Semester Examination of University, shall be awarded R grade irrespective of his/her performance in the Continuous Semester Assessment, i.e. internal assessment.
- v) The concerned teacher shall submit the marks of internal assessment and external practical examination to the Director UIT in duplicate (one for Examination Branch of HPU and another as an Office copy of UIT) and retain one copy with himself/herself, as per the schedule mentioned in Academic Calendar.
- vi) However, the conversion of marks into GPI would be done by the examination branch of University and marks sheet shall contain Letter Grade, SGPI/CGPI and Credit Earned by the candidate.

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2. Grade Point Index (GPI) (Already Approved)

The method of grading shall remain an integral part of the course structure prescribed for all B. Tech. Programmes of UIT. In the final marks card, a student shall be issued Grade Point Index (GPI) on the basis of his/her performance in opted courses of study. The GPI shall be computed Semester-wise as well as in a cumulative manner at the end of each semester. The SGPI (Semester Grade Point Index) is an indicator of the overall Academic Performance of a student in all the courses he/she has registered during a given semester.

For example, if the grades awarded to a student are G_1, G_2, \dots, G_n in n number of courses of a semester with corresponding credits C_1, C_2, \dots, C_n , then the SGPI may be calculated as:

$$SGPI = \frac{C_1 G_1 + C_2 G_2 + \dots + C_n G_n}{C_1 + C_2 + \dots + C_n}$$

Similarly, the CGPI (Cumulative Grade Point Index) indicates the overall academic performance of a student in all the courses registered up to and including the latest completed semester/supplementary examination. It is computed in the same manner as the SGPI, considering all the courses (say, m) and may be computed as:

$$CGPI = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^m C_i G_i}{\sum_{i=1}^m C_i}$$

2.1 Academic Performance Requirement:

- i) The minimum CGPI for award of B. Tech. degree is 5.0.
- ii) In case CGPI of the candidate is less than 5.0, then the candidate shall be given chance to improve his/her CGPI (within maximum allowed period of the programme) only after the declaration of his/her result of 8th semester examination. The candidate shall have to apply for improvement in his/her selected subjects along with dates of regular examinations of the relevant semester (odd/even). No separate examination shall be conducted for such candidate(s).
- iii) Out of the previous marks obtained and the marks obtained in the latest improvement exam for the subject, best of the two shall be considered.

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Courses from different Emerging Fields listed for Honours degree in syllabi of his/her branch.

5.2 B. Tech. (Hons.) Degree with Specialisation:

A student will be eligible to get a degree of **B. Tech. (Hons.)** in his/her branch with Specialisation in an Emerging Field of his/her branch, if he/she completes an additional 20 credits out of the Additional Courses of a particular Emerging Field listed for Honours degree in syllabi of his/her branch.

5.3 B. Tech. (Hons.) Degree with Minor Specialisation:

A student will be eligible to get a degree of **B. Tech. (Hons.)** in his/her branch with Minor Specialisation in an Emerging Field, if he/she completes an additional 20 credits out of the Additional Courses listed in a particular Emerging Field for Honours degree in syllabi of any of the other branches.

The Additional 20 credits for the either of the above Undergraduate (Honours) degree shall be completed by the candidate through MOOCs/SWAYAM portal or any other online mode recognised/approved by the Competent Authority, Government of India.

6. Rules for awarding a particular Undergraduate (Honours) degree:

- i) The candidate will be eligible to get a particular Undergraduate Honours degree only if he/she completes his/her B. Tech. in his/her branch with **CGPI ≥ 9.0** , without any "Reappear" and without any Letter Grade which includes **B, C, D, E** or **R** in any of the courses completed through UIT from 1st to 8th semester (3rd to 8th Semester for Lateral Entry Candidates with $\geq 75\%$ aggregate marks in Diploma). However, if Reappear and/or Letter Grade **B, C, D, E** or **R** gets revised to **O** or **A** due to re-evaluation/rechecking process, then he/she shall become eligible, subject to the condition that candidate acquires requisite additional credits as per rules listed at Sr. No. 5.
- ii) The Letter Grade/Grade Points (if any) acquired through MOOCs/SWAYAM shall not be counted for overall **CGPI** and only additional 20 credits completed shall be counted.

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- iii) The courses opted for additional credits acquired by candidate for Honours degree should be different from the courses contained in the curriculum of UIT from 1st to 8th semester for B. Tech. programmes.
- iv) One course shall compulsorily be opted from the list of **Open Electives** and rest from the **Emerging Field(s)** listed for honours degree in the syllabi of branch concerned.
- v) These additional courses opted for honours degree can be studied/completed by candidate during 3rd to 8th semester.
- vi) The Director UIT shall nominate a Faculty member as a Department Level MOOC Coordinator to guide and facilitate the students throughout the course and facilitate/conduct the practical and examination sessions.
- vii) Certificate of completion of a course through MOOCs/SWAYAM etc. shall be provided by the organisation(s) where student has enrolled for online courses to acquire additional credits and Examination/evaluation shall also be conducted by the same organisation(s).
- viii) The candidate will have to submit the copies of certificates, bearing additional credits earned through MOOC/SWAYAM for honours degree, to the UIT-SWAYAM Co-ordinator. The details of total additional credits earned by the candidate for a particular Honours degree would be submitted by UIT (after the completion of the 8th semester) to the Examination branch of Himachal Pradesh University for further necessary action.
- ix) The cost, including registration, examination fee etc., incurred in completion/studying of additional courses for Honours degree, will be borne by the candidate himself/herself.

The State Govt. has taken a decision to promote the 1st and 2nd year graduate students to the next year. Accordingly, the above matter was placed before the Committee in its meeting held on 10-11-2020 constituted for the said purpose. The Committee after detailed deliberations on the issues recommends as per **Annexure-A**. the said recommendations is placed before the Standing Committee of the Academic Council for its approval.)

Point for Consideration:

To consider the minutes of the meeting held on 10-11-2020 with regard to promoting the 1st and 2nd Year Graduate students to next year as per decision taken by the State Govt. for approval of the Standing Committee of the Academic Council.

The meeting of the committee constituted vide notification No.1-104/2000-IIPU (Genl.) Vol-IV date 04-05-2020 to examine and consider the UGC Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar to the Universities in view of COVID-19] for taking decision regarding promoting the Ist and IInd Year Graduate Students to next year as per the decision taken by State Govt. was held on 10th November, 2020 at 11:00 AM in the Committee Room of the University.

At the very outset, the Chairman of the Committee Prof. Arvind Kalia (Dean of Studies) welcomed the members to the meeting and thereafter, the discussion on the subject matter was started. The Secretary (Higher Education) to the Government of H.P. vide his letter No.EDN-A-Kha (15)-3/2018-1 dated 2nd November, 2020 regarding annual examination of first and second year Under Graduate students of 2019-20 years has conveyed the decision of Government to promote the students enrolled in 1st and 2nd year U.G. Courses for academic session 2019-20 to next academic year on the basis of UGC Guidelines dated 27-04-2020 as under:-

In case the situation does not appear to be normal in view of COVID-19, in order to maintain "social distancing", safety and health of the students, grading of students could be composite of 50% marks on the basis of pattern of internal evaluation adopted by the Universities and remaining 50% marks can be awarded on the basis of performance in previous semester only (if available). The internal evaluation can be continuous evaluation, prelims, mid-semester, internal assignments or whatever name, if given for students progression.

In the situation where previous semester or previous year marks are not available, particularly in the first year of annual pattern of examinations, 100% evaluation may be done on the basis of internal evaluation.

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The provision for intermediate semester examinations is only for the current academic session (2019-20) in view of COVID-19 pandemic, while maintain safety and health of all the stakeholders and sanctity and quality of examinations."

In view of the above in the first instance, the category/ies of students who are to be covered under this scheme are as under:

1. The first and second year regular students of B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., OT/ MIL class such as Shastri, etc.
2. The students of the ICDEOL.
3. Students of first and second year under semester system such as BBA, BCA etc., 2nd and 4th semesters.
4. The students having compartment in previous year/ semester.
5. The students appeared in the capacity of late College Student.

In view of the above decision of the Government:

- (a) 50% marks are to be awarded on the basis of the internal evaluation adopted by the University.
- (b) 50% marks can be awarded on the basis of performance in previous semester/ year only (if available).
- (c) In the situations where previous semester or previous year marks are not available, particularly in the first year of annual pattern of examination, 100% evaluation may be done on the basis of internal evaluation.
- (d) If the student wishes to improve the grade, he/she may appear in supplementary examinations for such subjects during next semester.

The Committee after thorough deliberations resolved that in view of the present situation, the decision of the Government as conveyed by the Secretary (Higher Education), the Government of H.P., can be implemented in the following way:

- (1) For the students of 1st year of BA., B.Sc., B.Com., OT/MIL, etc. who are under annual system where previous semester or previous year marks are not available 100% evaluation be done on the basis of internal evaluation.
- (2) For the students of 2nd year of BA., B.Sc., B.Com., OT/MIL, etc. under annual system 50% marks are to be awarded on the basis of the pattern of internal evaluation and 50% marks are to be adopted on the performance of their 1st year examination, i.e. taking into consideration their SEM-1 of the first year.
- (3) For 1st year of students under semester system such as BBA, BCA, etc. who were in 2nd semester 50% marks are to be awarded on the basis of pattern of internal evaluation and 50% marks are to be awarded on the basis of the performance of their 1st semester. Similar criteria is to be adopted for the 2nd year students, i.e. who are in 4th semester, 50% marks are to be awarded on the basis of the internal assessment and 50% marks are to be awarded on the basis of the performance of their 3rd semester.


- (4) For compartment students IDP's marks are to be awarded on the basis of average of the paper/s they have cleared/ passed.
- (5) For ICDEOL candidates, the ICDEOL may do internal evaluation of the candidates and supply the awards accordingly to the Examination Branch.
- (6) For late college students it was decided that average of their marks of the papers in which they have passed, would be taken into consideration for their promotion.


After receiving the awards from the Colleges as well as calculating their performance in previous semester/ year in proportion of 50 : 50 for Third Year and 100% for the 1st Year the case may be, the total of the marks would be taken into account and thereafter at 20% the marks 70:30 i.e. Theory : I.A. or 50 : 30 : 20 i.e. Theory : Practical : Internal Assessment (I.A.) shall be posted. The fraction of marks in the case .5 and above may be rounded to higher number and below .5 be rounded to the lower number. The entry of awards of T and practicals if already done, shall be treated as null.



Item - 4 Request of Researchers of Biotechnology & Microbiology for their eligibility for Life Science and other posts as per UGC Guidelines.

The BoS was informed that Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has forwarded the request of the Researchers of Biotechnology & Microbiology addressed to Hon'ble Chief Minister to allow them to be considered for the positions of Assistant Professors in Life Science for positions advertised by State Public Service Commission which presently is not the practice although they are allowed to appear in UGC NET/SET in Life Sciences and several State Governments allow the Microbiology & Biotechnology Graduates for teaching positions in Life Science. As per UGC guidelines 2013, the eligibility criteria for appointment of teachers and other academic staff in higher education is master degree with 55% marks in a relevant/allied subject from any Indian University. They have also requested for creation of college order in Microbiology/Biotechnology and introduction of Microbiology/ Biotechnology courses in government colleges of H.P. The Departmental Council has also recommended that the State Govt. may be requested to consider the demand of the Biotechnology / Microbiology Graduates to consider them for the positions of Life Science in State after approval of the BoS and Academic Council. The suggestions/ recommendation of the BOS is required in this connection.

Decision Taken: The BoS recommended that since the Biotechnology & Microbiology students are eligible for UGC-CSIR NET and are also considered for teaching positions in the field of Life Science in several states, their candidature may also be considered for Teaching positions in the area of Life/ Allied Sciences by State Govt. for College Cadre posts as per the UGC Guidelines-2018. Further, keeping in view the usefulness of these modern Life Science subjects globally, BoS was also of the view that these subjects should also be introduced in Government colleges in Himachal Pradesh as well as at 10+2 level as elective subject like Environment Science. Further it was also recommended that State Govt. should be requested by the University to have at least one teaching position for Microbiology/ Biotechnology in these colleges/ schools wherever so that the students can be benefited by these advanced Life Science subjects.

Any other Item 1: Revision of Course Curriculum of B.Sc. (Hons.) Biotechnology under New Yearly system of CBCS

The BoS was informed that due to switch over of CBCS system at UG level in the state from semester to yearly system, the revision of the course curricula to suit the changed system was done and the total outline of the Course was finalized. Further, due to urgency, the detailed syllabi for the courses of first year was also finalized in the previous meeting of BoS and it was desired that the syllabus for the second and third year will be finalized before start of second year. Subsequently, the appropriate changes/amendments as suggested by the members according to the finalized outline were incorporated well in time. Draft of the revised Course Curriculum/Syllabus prepared for second and third year was placed before the committee for comments/suggestions.

Decision Taken: After detailed deliberations and discussions on various issues vis-a-vis the usefulness of the curriculum for the students, the detailed syllabus of B.Sc. (hons.) Biotechnology, after incorporating required/ suggested changes, was finalized and approved as per Annexure-III.

Finally, while appreciating the efforts of the Department and University, the BoS was of the view that the focus should be on strengthening the existing facilities for improving quality and introducing need based job oriented courses like Food Technology, Industrial Microbiology, Biotechnology Bioinformatics, Biochemistry and Forensic Science etc. with focus skill development, entrepreneurship possibilities and more hands on practical and job training for increasing employability of the students and the Department of Life Science especially Biotechnology and Microbiology should take lead in this.
