

हिमाचल प्रदेश विश्वविद्यालय कार्यकारिणी परिषद् की वर्ष 2022 की पाँचवीं नियमित बैठक में मैं आप सभी सम्माननीय सदस्यों का हार्दिक स्वागत एवं अभिनन्दन करता हूँ। सर्वप्रथम मैं समिति को यह अवगत करवा रहा हूँ कि प्रदेश में आचार संहिता लागू होने की वजह से किसी भी प्रकार के वित्तिय एवं पदोन्नति लाभ के लिए यदि कोई मद हो तो उन पर चर्चा नहीं होगी और यदि कोई मद अति आवश्यक हो उस परिस्थिति में अधिसूचना भी आचार संहिता समाप्त होने के पश्चात् ही जारी की जाये।

मैं आप सभी सम्माननीय सदस्यों को सूचित करना चाहता हूँ कि दिनांक 2 नवम्बर से 4 नवम्बर, 2022 तक राष्ट्रीय मूल्यांकन एवं प्रत्यायन परिषद् (नैक) द्वारा हिमाचल प्रदेश विश्वविद्यालय का दौरा किया गया इस दौरे में हिमाचल प्रदेश विश्वविद्यालय ने NAAC ग्रेडिंग में अपना ए ग्रेड कायम रखने में सफलता प्राप्त की है। हिमाचल प्रदेश विश्वविद्यालय को ए ग्रेड मिलना पूरे प्रदेश के लिए बहुत ही सम्मान की बात है। हालांकि इस बार ग्रेडिंग की प्रक्रिया पहले की प्रक्रिया से बिल्कुल भिन्न थी। यहां यह भी बता देना उचित रहेगा कि पहले सारी ग्रेडिंग NAAC टीम के मूल्यांकन पर निर्भर करती थी जबकि इस बार की ग्रेडिंग NAAC टीम के हाथ में सिर्फ 30 प्रतिशत ही था। जबकि 70 प्रतिशत एस एस आर पर आधारित मूल्यांकन था। एस एस आर की रिपोर्ट पहले ही जमा करवा दी गई थी। इस हिसाब से जब दोनों को मिलाकर ग्रेड देने की बात हो तो निश्चित रूप में एक बहुत बड़ी परीक्षा थी जिसमें विश्वविद्यालय पूरी तरह से खरा उतरा है।








After perusal of the agenda note placed before the Committee and careful consideration of the documents attached with the agenda i.e. representation of the petitioner dated 21.05.2018, Orders of erstwhile Hon'ble HPAT in OA No. 5001 of 2018 dated 21.08.2018, decision of the Finance Committee taken in its meeting on 18.01.2019 and orders of the Hon'ble High Court in CWP No. 774 of 2020 dated 25.05.2022 and R&P rules notified by the state Government in respect of Block Medical Officers and Chief Medical Officers, the Finance Committee observed as under:

1. That the petitioner Dr. Vinay Kumar, presently posted as Medical Officer in HP University, Summer Hill was appointed as Medical Officer on a fixed salary of Rs. 16000/- for 89 days as a stop gap arrangement on 08.02.2006. Subsequently his services were regularized by the University on 16.02.2012.
2. That Dr. Vinay Kumar made a representation to the Registrar, HPU on 21.05.2018 requesting to designate him as Chief Medical Officer and allow the Pay Scale of the Chief Medical Officer as well on the analogy of his predecessor Dr. S.K. Sharma.
3. That Dr. Vinay Kumar filed OA bearing No. 5001/2018 before the Hon'ble HPAT and the same was disposed off on 21.08.2018 with the directions to take a final decision on the basis of representation after affording an opportunity of being heard to the applicant by 30.09.2018.
4. The orders of the Hon'ble HPAT were complied with by the Registrar, HPU as opportunity of being heard was afforded on 27.09.2018 and it was ordered that the matter may be placed before the Finance Committee and the Executive Committee for the upgradation as Block Medical Officer and Chief Medical Officer as a measure Personal to the applicant as per R&P rules of the state government or as the competent authorities decides.

5. The matter was placed before the Finance Committee vide agenda item No. 57 in its meeting of 18.01.2019 and was rejected by the Committee and the decision of Finance Committee was ratified by the Executive Council.
 6. The petitioner approached Hon'ble High Court vide CWP No. 774 of 2020 and the Hon'ble High Court in its orders of dated 25.05.2022 directed the Finance Committee to consider and decide the representation of 21.05.2018 within a period of four weeks after giving an opportunity of being heard. The petitioner was given an opportunity of being heard by the Registrar on 08.06.2022 at 3:00 p.m. and the petitioner was informed that his matter will be placed before the Finance Committee.

After careful consideration of the representation of dated 21.05.2018 of the petitioner and the facts brought to the notice of the Committee besides reply of the University filed in CWP 774 of 2022, it is concluded that the request of the petitioner to designate him as Chief Medical Officer and allow the scale of the post as well cannot be accepted since the post of the Medical Officer has been created in the University as a single cadre post. As per R&P rules of Chief Medical Officer annexed with the agenda, elevation to the Chief Medical Officer by promotion from amongst the Block Medical Officers with 05 years regular service or regular combined with continuous adhoc service rendered, if any in the grade or 15 years' service as Block Medical Officer and Medical Officer combined out of which three years' service in hard/rural areas is essential. The petitioner himself has accepted in his representation dated 21.05.2018 that he has completed only 06 years of regular services (Now 10 years) and stated further that as per R&P rules of the State Government, the conditions of R&P rules are relaxable. H.P. University has not adopted the said R&P rules. So far as drawing analogy with Dr. S.K. Sharma was granted pay scale of Medical Officer Grade I and II by the University on the pattern of H.P. Government which was applicable w.e.f. 01.01.1986. This benefit to Dr. S.K. Sharma was granted after completion of 18 years of services, whereas petitioner has completed 10 years of regular services till date. However, all financial benefits under ACPS (4-9-14) have been granted to the petitioner and is presently in the pay scale of 37400-67000+8600 GP.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts brought before the Finance Committee, request of the petitioner is not acceptable. The Finance Committee direct and authorize the Registrar, H.P. University to take further necessary action in the matter by issuing detailed speaking orders as per decision of the committee.

Such seats being supernumerary does not have any bearing on the students as the post is over and above the sanctioned seats for each teacher.

Decision: The Academic Council has unanimously accorded its approval to ratify the decision taken by the University in the above matter.



Respected Madam/Sir,


As you are aware that the University Grants Commission has issued 'the UGC guidelines on examination and academic calendar in view of the Covid-19 pandemic' on 16th July, 2021, wherein UGC has stipulated the provision of refund of fees on account of all cancellations of admissions/ migrations of students during the academic session 2021-2022. Also, UGC on 12th July, 2022 has requested the higher educational institutions to fix the last date of their under graduate admission process after declaration of result of class XII by CBSE so as to provide sufficient time to such students for admission in under graduate courses. Also, it may be noted that several entrance examinations including CUET, JEE Main, JEE Advance etc. have been delayed, due to which admissions may continue up to October, 2022.

In view above, and in order to avoid financial hardships being faced by parents, it has been decided by UGC that full refund of fees should be made by the higher educational institutions on account of all cancellations of admissions/ migrations of students up to October 31, 2022 for the academic session 2022- 2023 as a special case. It is made clear that the entire fee, including all charges, should be refunded (i.e., there should be zero cancellation charges) on account of cancellations/ migrations up to October 31, 2022. Thereafter, on cancellation/ withdrawal of admissions up to December 31, 2022, the entire fee collected from a student should be refunded in full after deducting not more than Rs.1000/- as processing fee.

All the Higher Educational Institutions are requested to ensure the compliance of the UGC directions in respect of refund of fee in view of COVID-19 Pandemic related factors.

1.0 Title and Commencement

These regulations will be called the HPU Regulations for CBCS and Continuous Comprehensive Assessment Grading Pattern (CCAGP) for PG Programmes. These regulations shall come into force from the academic year 2022-2023.

3.0 Definitions

3.1 Course: A course is a set of instructions pertaining to a pre-determined content (Syllabus), delivery mechanism, and learning objectives. Every course offered may have three components associated with the teaching-learning process of the course, namely:

- a. Lecture – symbolized as *L*;
- b. Tutorial – symbolized as *T*; and
- c. Practical – symbolized as *P*.

A course can have one, two or all the three above-mentioned components. That means that a course may have only lecture component, only tutorial component, only practical component, or a combination of any two or all the three components.

One *L* stands for one, one-hour lecture session per week; One *T* stands for one, two-hour tutorial session per week consisting of participatory discussion (between teacher and students or teaching assistant and students) or self-study/desk work/brief seminar presentations etc. by students (these can include such novel methods that make a student absorb and assimilate more effectively the contents delivered in lecture classes); and One *P* stands for one, two-hour practice (laboratory work)

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session per week (this consists of hands-on experience, laboratory experiments, field studies, case studies, etc. that equip students to acquire the much-required skill component).

3.2 Credit: Each course is rated in terms of **credits** or **credit hours**. Every one-hour session per week of L amounts to one (1.0) credit per semester. Every two-hour session per week of T or P amounts to one (1.0) credit per semester.

One semester extends over a period of 20 weeks in total out of which 16 weeks are for the teaching-learning process and four (4) weeks are for testing process (i.e. mid-term (Minor) test(s), homework assignments, and End-semester examination (including preparatory period if any).

The total credits earned by a student at the end of the semester upon successfully completing the course will be $L+T+P$. The credit pattern of the course is indicated as $L : T : P$.

To cite an example, if a course is of 4 credits, then the different credit distribution patterns in $L:T:P$ format could be as follows:

4 : 0 : 0	(four lecture credits only (no tutorial and practical credits) per week).
2 : 1 : 1	(two lecture credits, one tutorial credit, and one practical credit per week).
0 : 2 : 2	(no lecture credits, two tutorial credits, and two practical credits per week).
1 : 2 : 1	(one lecture credit, two tutorial credits, and one practical credit per week).
2 : 2 : 0	(two lecture credits, two tutorial credits, and no practical credit per week).
0 : 4 : 0	(no lecture credits, four tutorial credits only, and no practical credits per week).
1 : 1 : 2	(one lecture credit, one tutorial credits, and two practical credits per week).
2 : 0 : 2	(two lecture credits, no tutorial credits, and two practical credits per week).
0 : 0 : 4	(no lecture credits, no tutorial credits, and four practical credits only per week).
1 : 0 : 3	(one lecture credits, no tutorial credits, and three practical credits per week).
3 : 1 : 0	(three lecture credits, one tutorial credit, and no practical credits per week).
0 : 1 : 3	(no lecture credits, one tutorial credit, and three practical credits per week).
1 : 3 : 0	(one lecture credit, three tutorial credits, and no practical credit per week).
3 : 0 : 1	(three lecture credits, no tutorial credits, and one practical credit per week).
0 : 3 : 1	(no lecture credits, three tutorial credits, and one practical credit per week).

In each of these combinations, the first value stands for the same number of lecture instructions per week, whereas the last two values stand for double the number of tutorials/practical instructions per week.

The concerned PG Board of Studies (PG BoS) will decide the credit pattern for every course on the basis of requirements (to be discussed in the said PG BoS). However, generally a CGPA PG course shall be of 4 or 6 credits.

The PG Board of Studies, in each subject taught at HPU will identify the courses to be taught in each department. These PG courses will be labeled by an acronym that will comprise two parts. The four-letter prefix for the subject like GEOG for geography, GEOL for geology, SOCI for sociology, ECON for economics and so on. This will be followed by three-digit suffix starting with 301, 401 etc. for the level of the course. The 600 series will be reserved for research courses (Dissertation, Thesis etc.).

3.3 Types of Courses: Post-Graduate Boards of Studies, in all subjects, shall identify courses under the following three categories (Category three being Optional):-

- (i) Core Courses
- (ii) Elective Courses
- (iii) Research Courses

(i) **Core Courses:** Core Courses comprise a set of Courses identified as compulsory for students registered for PG (Masters') degree in a particular subject. This is the core requirement for a master's degree. **The Core Courses may be referred to as DSC Courses.**

AEC (Ability Enhancement Course): The Core Courses shall comprise one paper on Ability Enhancement, to be floated in IIIrd Semester and shall comprise 2 or 4 credits, but shall be Non-CGPA.

Note: Core courses of subjects other than the subject of a student's master's degree will be considered as Elective Courses for a student's PG programme.

(ii) **Elective Courses:** A Course that can be chosen from a number of options from a student's subject of master's degree or from outside (subjects other than a student's master's subject) is known as an Elective Course. In choosing the course here, student has considerable freedom of choice. He/she does not need to remain confined to his/her subject of master's degree only. These may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline/subject of a student's master's degree or which provides an extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures a candidate's proficiency/skill etc. All courses that a candidate takes after completing the core requirements will be considered as elective courses in case of a student's master's programme.

The Elective Courses can be divided into two categories:

- a. **Discipline Specific Elective (DSE):** It shall comprise the papers in which the students shall have a choice from a set of courses offered by the concerned department.
- b. **Open/Generic Elective (GE):** It shall comprise courses chosen from an unrelated discipline/subject with an intention to seek exposure.

NOTE: There shall be two Generic Elective Courses, one each to be introduced in the IInd and IVth Semesters respectively, of 4 credits each (For MBA, the norms of AICTE shall be applicable).

An Elective Course that is specially designed to acquire special/advanced knowledge (might be for the specialization required for a particular student's programme) as a supplement study/support study to a project work or an elective course for which no teacher is available in the department and so a candidate studies such a course on his/her own (with might be an advisory support by a teacher) is called a **Self-Study Elective**.

All courses (core as well as elective) offered in the disciplines / subjects other than the subject of a student's master's degree are treated as elective courses for the PG programme of that student.

(iii) **Research Courses:** There will be some PG courses in each department which will involve doing research. These would include Master's Thesis, Project Work, etc.

There will be a prescribed syllabus for the Research Course. However, the contents of these courses will be governed by the directions or decisions of the PG BoS of the concerned programme.

These are special courses involving application of knowledge in solving, analyzing, and / or exploring real-life situations or difficult problem.

3.4 Course Evaluation (Evaluation of the Students)

All courses (Core and Elective) involve an evaluation system of students that has the following two components:-

- a. **Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA)** accounting for 20-40 percent of the final grade that a student gets in a course
- b. **End-Semester Examination (ESE)** accounting for the remaining 80-60 percent of the final grade that the student gets in a course.

NOTE: The assessment for the courses offered in the Dept of Music shall be in accordance with their curriculum.

- (i) **Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA):** This would have the following components:
- (a) **Classroom Attendance** – Each student will have to attend a minimum of 75% Lectures / Tutorials / Practicals. A student having less than 75% attendance will not be allowed to appear in the End-Semester Examination (ESE).
- Provided that those having between 74% and 65% attendance will apply for exemption in a prescribed form accompanied by clear reason(s) for absence to the authorized functionaries.
 - Provided that those having between 64% and 50% attendance will apply for exemption in a prescribed form accompanied by a Medical Certificate from a Government Hospital.
 - Provided that exemption from 75% attendance will be given to those participating in prescribed co-curricular activities (e.g. NCC, NSS, Youth Festivals, Sports etc.) to the extent of 25% (making the necessary attendance as 50% in these cases). However, the claim for this exemption should be supported by authenticated certificate from the concerned college / University authorities.
 - Provided further that those getting the exemptions, except for those getting exemptions for co-curricular activities, will not be entitled for getting the CCA marks for classroom attendance as given below.

Those having greater than 75% attendance (for those participating in Co-curricular activities, 25% will be added to per cent attendance) will be awarded CCA marks as follows:-

> 75% but < 80%	1 marks
80% to 85%	2 marks
> 85 but < 90%	3 marks
90% to 95%	4 marks
> 95%	5 marks

NOTE: If a student is not permitted to appear in the ESE due to shortage of attendance beyond the

exemption limit (i.e. < 50% attendance), he / she shall be deemed to have 'dropped' the course. However, such candidate, on his/her written request to be made immediately, can be permitted to redo the missed semester after completing the rest of the programme or whenever the course is offered subsequently. This redoing would mean complete course including CCA and ESE.

(b) **Mid-Term (Minor) Tests:** There will be at least one mid-term test to be conducted after the completion of at least 50% syllabus.

Evaluated test booklets will be provided to the students (shown in the class) and they can be given photocopies of the same at the cost of photocopying and the administrative effort involved. The amount chargeable will be determined by the college/University administration and can be revised from time to time.

In laboratory courses (having only practical (P) component), the students will be tested on the basis of laboratory exercises given by the course teacher concerned. Rest of the procedure will remain the same as above.

(c) **Seminar/Assignment/Term Paper** – The students shall be asked to participate in seminars/prepare assignments/write term paper etc. that the course teacher gives to the students. At least one such seminar/assignment/term paper will have to be done for each course in a semester.

For the Correspondence Courses and Distance Education Courses (through the ICDEOL of HPU) the same can be done online through e-mail or other electronic mediums.


The division of marks for Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA) shall be as under:

a. Attendance	5 marks
b. Mid-term tests	} The marks for categories "b" and "c" shall be decided by the departments.
c. Seminar/Assignment/Term Paper	

(ii) **End-Semester Examination (ESE):** The 80-60 percent of the final grade of the student in a course will be on the basis of an end-semester examination (ESE) that will be of three hours duration and cover the whole syllabus of the course.

- For the Odd Semesters the ESE will be in the month of October / November and for Even Semesters it will be in the month of April / May.
- A candidate who does not pass the examination (ESE) in any course(s) (or due to some reason is not able to appear in the ESE, other conditions being fulfilled, and so is considered as 'Fail'), shall be permitted to appear in such failed course(s) in the subsequent ESE to be held in the following October / November or April / May.
- The registration for the ESE will be done at the time of the enrollment for the course at the beginning of the semester. The fee for the ESE will also be collected tentatively one month prior to the commencement of the examinations.
- If a student is not permitted to appear in the ESE due to shortage of attendance beyond the exemption limit (i.e. < 50% attendance), he / she shall be deemed to have 'dropped' the course. However, such candidate, on his/her written request to be made immediately, can be permitted to redo the missed semester after completing the rest of the programme or whenever the course is offered subsequently. This redoing would mean complete course including CCA and ESE.

To qualify a particular course, the students need to pass in, **both**, Continuous Comprehensive


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Assessment (CCA) and End-Semester Examination (ESE), failing which the student shall be considered to have failed in the concerned course and shall have to take the exam for the said course again. In case the student fails the CCA, his form for ESE shall be withheld and a notice put up in the department to the effect. The student, then, shall have to again take a Mid-term (Minor) Test and submit an assignment in the concerned course and pass the same. If the student fails the ESE, he/she shall have to take the concerned end-semester examination again.

Question paper setting for AEC (Ability Enhancement Course) shall be external, under the aegis of the CoE, however the evaluation shall be internal, by the concerned Department.

NOTE: The pattern of assessment for Distance Education and Open Learning shall follow the same pattern as followed in the PG Dept. However, the component of attendance shall not be counted and the entire internal assessment shall be based on seminar/assignment/term paper. The pattern of assessment for Private candidates shall not have the component of Internal assessment. They shall have an End-semester Examination, on the same pattern as Regular and ICDEOL, but of 100 marks.

Conducting of End-Semester Examinations: Please refer to points 6.45 to 6.75 of the University Ordinance.

Grading

- a) The marks obtained in the CCA and the ESE will be combined and used for the deciding of the course grade that the student will be getting. Absolute grading will be done by the Office of the CoE HPU for each course class in all the colleges as is described in the next section. Only Absolute grading will be used and it shall be done in accordance with the following table:

Determining GPA and CGPA

For each student the Grade Point Average (GPA) and the Cumulated Grade Point Average (CGPA) will

be determined by the CoE office of the HPU as follows:

$$GPA \text{ or } CGPA = (\sum C_i G_i) / (\sum C_i)$$

Where, C_i is the credit earned for course i (i varying from 1 to n) and G_i is the grade point obtained by the student in course i (i varying from 1 to n), n being the number of courses passed so far by a student.

At the completion of the PG programme the CGPA will be determined for the whole programme and will be assigned letter grades as below:

- (a) MCA (To be decided by the respective Department)
 - (b) M. Tech. (To be decided by the respective Department)
- (5) **For PG Diploma, Certificate & Advanced Diploma Programmes**
To be decided by the respective Departments

NOTE: There shall be no direct admission to IIInd Semester

6.0 Scheme of Instruction

(1) **Master's Degree Programme:** (See Appendix – I and II)

- (i) A master's degree programme is of 4 semesters- two years- duration. A candidate can avail a maximum of 10 semesters- 5 years (in one stretch) – to complete Master's Degree (including blank semesters (semesters in which candidate does not take any course), if any). Provided that a maximum of three attempts are allowed to pass any course.

However, whenever a candidate opts for blank semester(s), he / she will have to study the prevailing courses offered by the department(s) when he/ she continues (re-joins) his / her studies.

It was also decided that in the science subjects there will be Credit Based System only for the time being and in other subjects, there will be Choice Based Credit System.
2. It was also recommended that the chapter of Ph.D. will not be included in this Regulation as the admission to Ph.D programme under CBCS will be implemented from the academic session 2024-25 after completion of first batch of P.G. Courses under CBCS.


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3. It was also decided that a copy of Regulation-2022 for P.G. Classes be forwarded to all the Deans/ Chairpersons/Directors of the Faculty/ Teaching Departments/Institutes to check the same for incorporation in the Regulation-2022 in the near future.
4. It was also decided that a panel of Paper Setters for setting the question papers alongwith Model Question Papers be supplied to the Deputy Registrar(Secrecy) within five days.





At the very outset, the Chairman of the Committee welcomed all the Committee members present in the meeting and thereafter Committee deliberated and discussed the matter and made the following recommendations:-

16.12 (Ammendment in HPU ordinance 16.12) Procedure for admission to Ph.D.

Program:

1. The process for admission to Ph.D program will be on the basis of 106 point roster on the analogy of M.Phil/LLM qualified Examination course. The 25 % seat(s) shall be open for all and remaining 75 % seats for Bonafied Himachali. The Admission to Ph.D. Program shall be made on the basis of direct and entrance test mode.
2. Direct admission will be made on the basis of UGC NET-JRF and other equivalent Fellowships through National Level Entrance test agencies supported by Academic Merit. The admission to Ph.D. Program through direct mode shall be made in the month of July every year.

Preferences in the Direct admission shall be as under: -

- a) The first preference shall be given to UGC NET(JRF) and other equivalent fellowship holder candidates through National Level Test agency and the merit shall be drawn on the basis of Merit of P.G. Examinations. Moreover, the National Level fellowship holders must apply within the valid period as mentioned by the UGC and other awarding agencies.
 - b) For remaining seats, if available after 2(a), admission in Ph.D. Programme shall be made among other fellowship holders like NFSC, NFST, Maulana etc., on the basis of merit of the P.G. examination.
3. That the Entrance Test for the Ph.D. admission shall be conducted in the month of December every year.


The criteria for Entrance Test will as under: -

- a. Written Test will be of 80 Marks.
- b. Weightage will be maximum of 20 % of the marks obtained in the Entrance Test.

Weightage will be given to the candidate(s) as under: -

- i) NET-JRF and other equivalent fellowship-20% of the marks obtained in the Entrance Test by the Candidate.

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- ii) NET & GATE-15% of the marks obtained in the Entrance Test by the Candidate.
- iii) SLET/M.Phil-10% of the marks obtained in the Entrance Test by the Candidate.

Qualifying marks (Percentage) for all the candidates for Ph.D. program shall be 50% for General Category and 45 % for other reserved categories (SC/ST/PwD).


4. The concerned department/Institution will identify the categories for Supernumerary seats. The supernumerary seats for all categories shall be restricted to only one per Supervisor in each category in each department. The allotment of the next candidate to a supervisor shall be made only after the submission of Ph.D. thesis of the previously registered candidate against the supernumerary seat. Moreover, admissions for Ph.D program against all supernumerary seats shall be based on the merit of Entrance Test *along with the criteria/weightage mentioned in clause 3.*
5. It was decided that Plagiarism report shall be mandatory at the time of submission of Ph.D thesis.


The Committee recommended to place the recommendations of the Committee in the Standing Committee of the Academic Council for its considerations.



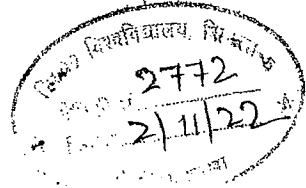

UGC Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar in view of the COVID-19 Pandemic – July, 2021

I. Introduction

Keeping in view the prevailing situation due to the COVID-19 pandemic; the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India regarding the cancellation of School Board examinations for class/grade-XII; the earlier order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court upholding the UGC's guidelines of July 6, 2020 regarding terminal semester/ final year examinations; the earlier UGC guidelines on examination and academic calendar dated April 29, 2020, July 6, 2020 and September 24, 2020; and, the larger interest of students, the following guidelines are being issued by the UGC in respect of examinations and the academic calendar for universities, colleges and institutions deemed to be universities (who are collectively called "**Higher Education Institutions**" in these guidelines) in continuation of the earlier guidelines.

II. Examinations

The provisions as contained in the guidelines issued earlier as mentioned above shall apply for the current academic session 2020-21. Further, the Terminal Semester/ Final Year Examinations (2020-2021) be compulsorily conducted in offline (pen & paper)/ online/ blended (online + offline) mode by no later than August 31, 2021 following the prescribed protocols/ guidelines related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

For intermediate semester/year students, assessment shall be based on internal evaluation and previous semester as suggested in 2020 guidelines.

III. Academic Calendar

The provisions contained in the UGC Guidelines dated 24.09.2020 shall be applicable for the academic session 2021-2022. For students of the intermediate semester/year, the Higher Education Institutions may start their academic session (in online/offline/blended mode) as early as possible, following the guidelines/directions related to the COVID-19 pandemic issued by the appropriate government/competent authority.

In addition, the following guidelines shall also apply regarding the academic calendar for the first-year under-graduate and post-graduate students in Higher Education Institutions:

1. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's order dated June 22, 2021 in Writ Petition(s) (Civil) No. 522 of 2021 (Mamta Sharma versus Central Board of Secondary Education & Others) has noted as follows:

*If there is a delay in declaration of result of the qualifying examinations, Higher Education Institutions may plan and start the academic session by October 18, 2021. The teaching-learning process may continue in offline/ online/ blended mode.

**Higher Education Institutions may plan for classes, breaks, conduct of examinations, semester break etc. during the period October 1, 2021 to July 31, 2022 following necessary protocols/guidelines/directions/advisories issued by the Central/State Governments and competent authorities from time to time, in view of the COVID-19 pandemic.

5. In view of the financial hardships being faced by parents due to lockdowns and related factors, a full refund of fees should be made on account of all cancellations of admissions/ migrations of students up to October 31, 2021 for the academic session 2021-2022 as a special case. It is made clear that the entire fee, including all charges, should be refunded (i.e. there should be zero cancellation charges) on account of cancellations/ migrations up to October 31, 2021. Thereafter, on cancellation/ withdrawal of admissions up to December 31, 2021, the entire fee collected from a student should be refunded in full after deducting not more than Rs. 1000/- as processing fee.
6. The guidelines issued by the UGC on April 29, 2020 and July 6, 2020 highlighting the modes of teaching, conduct of examinations, importance of physical & social distancing etc. should be read along with the present guidelines and shall remain mandatory, but the present guidelines shall prevail in the event of any conflict.
7. The present guidelines are subject to the advisories/directives issued by the apex statutory bodies/councils concerned, e.g., AICTE, NCTE, BCI, NMC, DCI, INC, PCI, AYUSH etc. regarding examinations and academic calendars.

Notwithstanding the present guidelines regarding the conduct of examinations and commencement of the next academic session, every Higher Education Institution shall ensure that it is prepared in all respects to carry out the academic activities following necessary protocols/guidelines/directions/advisories issued by the Central/State Governments or competent authorities from time to time, in view of the COVID-19 pandemic.

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"....Attorney General for India by pointing out that U.G.C. will be issuing necessary instructions to ensure that the admission process by the colleges and institutions should commence only after the declaration of results by the C.B.S.E. and I.C.S.E., including the State Boards."

Accordingly, Higher Education Institutions shall ensure that the admission process for undergraduate courses/programmes for the academic session 2021-2022 commences only after the declaration of results by the CBSE, ICSE and State Boards. It is expected that all the School Boards will declare their results for the class/grade-XII examinations by July 31, 2021.

2. Admissions to the first year courses/programmes for the session 2021-2022 shall be completed by no later than September 30, 2021. The last date for admissions to fill up the remaining vacant seats shall be October 31, 2021. The relevant documents of the qualifying examination can be accepted up to December 31, 2021.
3. The academic session 2021-2022 shall commence latest by October 1, 2021 for first semester/year students.
4. Accordingly, Higher Education Institutions shall follow the calendar given below for the academic session 2021-2022:
