

UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 4th September, 2020

No. F. 1-1/2020(DEB-I).—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of section 26 read with clause (j) of section 12 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956) and in supersession of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and University Grants Commission (Online Courses or Programmes) Regulations, 2018 except as respect of things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the University Grants Commission with the previous approval of the Central Government hereby makes the following regulations, namely:—

PART I

PRELIMINARY

1. **Short title, application and commencement.**— (1) These regulations may be called the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020.

- (2) These regulations lay down the minimum standards of instruction for the grant of degrees at the undergraduate and post graduate levels and grant of post graduate diploma, through Open and Distance Learning mode and Online mode and shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other regulations, Notifications, Guidelines or Instructions issued by the Commission.

- (3) These regulations shall apply to a University referred to under clause (f) of section 2 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956), an Institution Deemed to be University under section 3 of the said Act:

Provided that the University Grants Commission may, by order, exempt a Higher Educational Institution or Higher Educational Institutions from the application of these regulations.

- (4) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Definitions.**— In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,—

- (a) "Academic Council or Senate" means the body empowered to take decisions regarding all academic matters in a Higher Educational Institution including the decision permitting to offer Open and Distance Learning Programmes and/or Online Programmes in compliance to these regulations;
- (b) "Academic session" means duration of twelve months beginning either in January to February or in the month of July to August, as the case may be, of every calendar year;
- (c) "Act" means the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956);
- (d) "Centre for Internal Quality Assurance" (CIQA) means a Centre established by a Higher Educational Institution for ensuring the quality of programmes being offered in Open and Distance Learning mode and Online mode, as specified in Annexure-I;
- (e) "Commission" means the University Grants Commission established under the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956);
- (f) "Conventional mode" means a mode of providing learning opportunities through face to face interaction between the teacher and learner in regular class room environment but does not exclude supplementary instructions if any for the learner through use of online;
- (g) "Credit" means the Unit award gained by a learner with study efforts of minimum number of hours required to acquire the prescribed level of learning in respect of that Unit;

Provided that the programmes of the Higher Educational Institutions recognised by the Commission under UGC (Open and Distance Learning) Regulations, 2017 and UGC (Online Courses or Programmes) Regulations, 2018 shall remain valid programmes for the period as mentioned in the Commission Orders.

- (3) In the event of any Higher Educational Institution found offering programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode and/or Online mode without recognition of the Commission or in violation to any of the provisions of these regulations and guidelines or orders made there under, the Commission may—
- (i) issue Show-Cause Notice;
 - (ii) withdraw the recognition of a programme or some programmes or all the programmes for an academic session or withdraw the recognition, maximum up to next five academic sessions not only for such Open and Distance Learning programmes and/or Online programmes but also for other programmes offered by the institutions in regular and conventional mode;
 - (iii) if, in spite of above, the Higher Educational Institution is found continuing the violations, a First Information Report may be lodged against the officials or management of the errant Higher Educational Institution to take action as per law;
 - (iv) withhold or debar from receiving University Grants Commission grants;
 - (v) refer the matter to the Central or State Government, as applicable for withdrawal of Higher Educational Institution status;
 - (vi) take action as per the provisions of the Act or Rules or Regulations as applicable to the Higher Educational Institution;
 - (vii) put in the public domain a list of such defaulters Higher Educational Institutions;
 - (viii) in case of a non-recognized Higher Educational Institution offering programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode and/or Online mode, punitive action mentioned at clauses (i), (iii), (v) and (vii) shall be exercised by the Commission keeping in view future of the learners.

PART III

MAINTENANCE OF INFRASTRUCTURAL, ACADEMIC AND OTHER QUALITY STANDARDS BY HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

8. **Systems Management, Structure and Processes.**— (1) An Open University shall have designated Schools of Studies for design and development of programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode and, which shall be headed by a regular functionary on full time dedicated basis not below the rank of an Associate Professor and shall have appropriate and adequate academic, technical, administrative staff and infrastructural resources as specified in Annexure-IV. The Open University shall also have appropriate departments such as operational department for admissions, learner support and examinations.
- (2) An Open University shall have a designated Centre for Online Education (COE) for operationalising the programmes designed and developed by the Schools of Studies for Online Learning mode and, which shall be headed by Director, a regular functionary on full time dedicated basis not below the rank of an Associate Professor and shall have appropriate and adequate academic, technical, administrative staff and infrastructural resources as specified in Annexure-IV.
- (3) A Higher Educational Institution other than an Open University shall have a designated Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) for operationalising the programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode and/or Online mode, which shall be headed by Director, a regular functionary on fulltime dedicated basis not below the rank of an Associate Professor and shall have appropriate and adequate academic, technical, administrative staff and infrastructural resources as specified in Annexure-IV.







INQUIRY REPORT

The undersigned was appointed as an Inquiry Officer vide Order No. 13-2/2021-HPU(Estt.) dated 28.12.2021, to inquire into the article of charge framed against Dr. Pawan Kumar Attri, Senior Research Officer, IHS/DIS, under Rule-14 of the Central Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1965. The copy of the Memorandum of charge sheet was also sent with the above order.

The following article of charge has been framed in the Memorandum of charge-sheet:

Dr. Pawan Kumar Attri while working as Senior Research Officer was appointed as Co-ordinator of the Purchase and Inspection Technical Committee for E-tendering/purchasing Laboratory/Scientific equipments for M.Sc.(Environment Sciences) through GEM. Prior to upload the E-tender so prepared by the Co-ordinator, on E-tender Portal with the collaboration of the Stores Purchase Officer, an E-tender notice was prepared by the Co-ordinator and sent to the Public Relations Officer on 07.01.2020 for publication of the same in the Daily News Paper which was published in the Punjab Kesari News Paper on 09.01.2020 mentioning therein that interested bidders may visit the official website for more details. But actually the E-tender was never uploaded on the E-tender Portal. After publishing the E-tender notice in the Punjab News Paper on 09.01.2020, Dr. Pawan Kumar Attri being the Co-ordinator visited the office of the Stores Purchase Officer alongwith Sh. Mohan Lal, Clerk to upload the E-tender on the E-Tender Portal. In his statement before the Fact Finding Inquiry Officer, Dr. Pawan Kumar Attri has admitted that in compliance to the directions issued by Prof. R.P. Sharma telephonically regarding uploading E-Tendered documents, he visited the Stores Purchase Office repeatedly alongwith Sh. Mohan Lal, Clerk for doing the same. But due to non-connectivity/poor connectivity of network, the E-Tender could not be uploaded on E-tendering portal. But actually the E-tender should have been uploaded on the E-tender Portal prior to its publication in the daily news paper which has not been done in the instant case. Subsequently, the Public Relations Officer vide his letter No. 1-28/06-HPU/PRO-23 dated 26.02.2020, had forwarded the advertisement charges amounting to Rs. 78,722/- (Rs. Seventy eight thousand seven hundred twenty two only) received from the Global Network (Punjab Kesri), Chandigarh. No E-Tender was uploaded on the E-Tender Portal and no purchasing of Laboratory/Scientific equipments through GEM was carried out resulting into an un-necessary financial loss amounting to Rs. 78,722/- (Rs. Seventy eight thousand seven hundred only) to the exchequer of the University.



From the perusal of record pertaining to the inquiry vis-à-vis statements of the prosecution witnesses (Flag-'A'), it is clear that despite repeated sincere efforts undertaken by Dr. Pawan Kumar Attri, Co-ordinator of the Purchase and Inspection Technical Committee for E-tendering/purchasing Laboratory/Scientific equipments for M.Sc.(Environment Sciences) through GEM, the E-Tender could not be uploaded on the E-tender Portal due to non-connectivity/poor connectivity of network well in time and in the meantime the E-tender notice was published in the Punjab Kesary News Paper on 09.01.2020. Actually the E-Tender should have been uploaded on the E-tender Portal prior to its publication in the daily news paper but inadvertently due to lack of knowledge the laid down procedure could not be followed in the instant case. The entire record pertaining to the inquiry reflects that there is no malafide intention of anybody while dealing the matter. In lieu of publication of the E-tender in the Punjab Kesary News Paper, an advertisement charges bill amounting to Rs. 78,722/- (Rs. Seventy eight thousand seven hundred twenty two only) has been received from the Global Network(Punjab Kesary), Chandigarh by the Public Relations Officer, H.P.University, Shimla-5. The record also revealed that Dr. Pawan Kumar Attri being Co-ordinator of the Purchase and Inspection Technical Committee for E-tendering/purchasing Laboratory/Scientific equipments for M.Sc.(Environment Sciences) has not usurped/pilferaged or kept any money in his pocket but during the discharge of his official duties this bonafide error has been occurred for which nobody can be held responsible. The Inquiry has established that Dr. Pawan Kumar Attri did not have any malicious intent or deliberate motive to cause financial loss to the University. So by taking a lenient view the same may be treated as institutional liability.

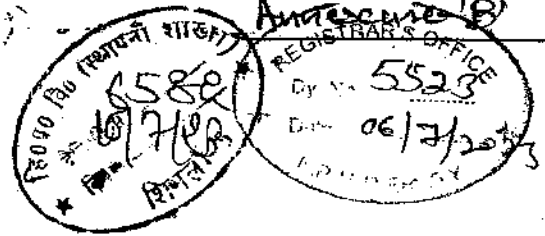



Provided that no such further inquiry shall be ordered unless it is intended to meet a situation where the Court has passed an order purely on technical grounds without going into the merits of the case.

(5) (a) An order of suspension made or deemed to have been made under this rule shall continue to remain in force until it is modified or revoked by the authority competent to do so.

(b) Where a Government servant is suspended or is deemed to have been suspended (whether in connection with any disciplinary proceeding or otherwise), and any other disciplinary proceeding is commenced against him during the continuance of that suspension, the authority competent to place him under suspension may, for reasons to be recorded by him in writing, direct that the Government servant shall continue to be under suspension until the termination of all or any of such proceedings.

(c) An order of suspension made or deemed to have been made under this rule may at any time be modified or revoked by the authority which made or is deemed to have made the order or by any authority to which that authority is subordinate.

For Government of India's Instructions on suspension and allied matters, see separate chapters.

PART V

PENALTIES AND DISCIPLINARY AUTHORITIES

11. Penalties

The following penalties may, for good and sufficient reasons and as hereinafter provided, be imposed on a Government servant, namely:—

Minor Penalties—

- (i) censure;
- (ii) withholding of his promotion;
- (iii) recovery from his pay of the whole or part of any pecuniary loss caused by him to the Government by negligence or breach of orders;
- ¹(iii) (z) reduction to a lower stage in the time-scale of pay for a period not exceeding 3 years, without cumulative effect and not adversely affecting his pension;
- (iv) withholding of increments of pay;

Clarification.—Since the penalty to the extent mentioned in clause (iii) (a) has been carved out of clause (v) specifically, it does not constitute a major penalty under clause (v). To ensure that this is clear, clause (v) is being amended.

(G.I., Dept. of Per. & Trg., O.M. No. 11012/4/86-Estt. (A), dated the 28th May, 1992.)

Major Penalties—

¹(v) save as provided for in clause (iii) (a), reduction to a lower stage in the time-scale of pay for a specified period, with further directions as to whether or not the Government servant will earn increments of pay during the period of such reduction and whether on the expiry of such period, the reduction will or will not have the effect of postponing the future increments of his pay;

(vi) reduction to lower time-scale of pay, grade, post or Service which shall ordinarily be a bar to the promotion of the Government servant to the time-scale of pay, grade, post or Service from which he was reduced, with or without further directions regarding conditions of restoration to the grade or post or Service from which the Government servant was reduced and his seniority and pay on such restoration to that grade, post or Service;

(vii) compulsory retirement;

(viii) removal from service which shall not be a disqualification for future employment under the Government;

(ix) dismissal from service which shall ordinarily be a disqualification for future employment under the Government.

²Provided that, in every case in which the charge of acceptance from any person of any gratification, other than legal remuneration, as a motive or reward for doing or forbearing to do any official act is established, the penalty mentioned in clause (viii) or clause (ix) shall be imposed:

Provided further that in any exceptional case and for special reasons recorded in writing, any other penalty may be imposed.

EXPLANATION.—The following shall not amount to a penalty within the meaning of this rule, namely:—

- (i) withholding of increment of a Government servant for his failure to pass any departmental examination in accordance with the rules or orders governing the Service to which he belongs or post which he holds or the terms of his appointment;
- (ii) stoppage of a Government servant at the efficiency bar in the time-scale of pay on the ground of his unfitness to cross the bar;
- (iii) non-promotion of a Government servant, whether in a substantive or officiating capacity, after consideration of his case, to a Service, grade or post for promotion to which he is eligible;

Item No. 1 : To place the matter before the Standing committee of the Academic Council /Executive Council for validation of degrees /diplomas of Under- Graduate and Post Graduate students of ICDEOL for the Academic Sessions 2016-2017 & 2017-2018 for all intent and purposes as per Annexure "A".

Explanatory note: Himachal Pradesh University has been established in 1970 as a State University by an Act of Himachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly and empowered to award degree as specified under Section 22 of UGC Act. All the Under-Graduate, Post-Graduate and Diploma Courses are duly approved through statutory bodies of the University and ICDEOL run only those courses through ODL mode which are running through Conventional mode the University. It is submitted that during the Academic session 2016-2017 & 2017-2018, the UGC did not granted recognition to the ICDEOL, H.P. University to run courses through ODL mode on the issue of territorial jurisdiction and UGC Regulations 2017 whereby UGC required CGPA points is 3.26 to run courses through Open and Distance Learning Programme whereas the NAAC CGPA of H.P. University ICDEOL was 3.21 at that time. On the other hand, the ICDEOL submitted all the requisite documents/information as required by the UGC(DEB) from time to time. Despite of responding all the communications, the UGC denied to grant Ex-post facto recognition to ICDEOL for the Academic year 2016-17 at a belated stage and NAAC score of H.P. University was 3.21 therefore HEI is not eligible to run courses through ODL mode for Academic session 2017-18. Being aggrieved by the act and conduct of the UGC (DEB), a CWP No. 1394 of 2018 was filed before the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. by the ICDEOL, H.P. University and the same is listed for 26.7.2023 for adjudication. During the subsistence of the pendency of the writ petition in the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. the degrees acquired by the students of ICDEOL for the Academic Sessions 2016-2017 and 2017- 2018 needs to be validated from the competent authority of the University vis-a-vis Academic Council /Executive Council of the University. ICDEOL runs only those courses through ODL mode for which the recognition was granted by the UGC (DEB) prior to 2016-17 and even at present UGC (DEB) had granted permission to run same UG/PG/Diploma courses through ODL mode till 2024-25.

Point for consideration:- To place the matter before the Standing committee of the Academic Council /Executive Council for validation of degrees /diplomas of Under- Graduate and Post Graduate students of ICDEOL for the Academic Sessions 2016-2017 & 2017-2018 for all intent and purposes.

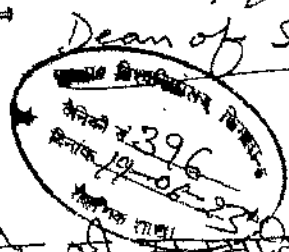

11.7 (i) Candidates reappearing in a subsequent examination shall be examined in accordance with the Scheme and syllabus in force at that time.

11.8 A candidate shall not be declared successful in the B.Ed. Examination, unless he/she obtains specified pass marks in each of the prescribed courses and internal assessment.

11.9 The aggregate marks obtained by a candidate in the Bachelor of Education examination shall be shown separately for theory and skill in teaching. Grading (On Four Points Letter Grades) will be done on the basis of reports submitted by the students in school internship/ school experiences of four week duration in the second semester by the Departmental Council, which will be shown in the result card.

11.10 The successful candidates shall be classified in three divisions as under:

(i) **First Division-** Those who obtain 60% or more of the aggregate marks

(ii) **Second Division-** Those who obtain 50% or more, but Less than 60% of the aggregate marks.

(iii) **Third Division-** Those who obtain less than 50% of the aggregate marks.

The division shall be shown separately in theory and in the Practical skill in teaching sessional work and practical activities. A candidate obtaining 75% marks of the aggregate shall be shown to have passed the examination with distinction.

11.11 A candidate who does not pass the Bachelor of Education Examination in three years (in regular mode) and 5 years (in distance mode) including the time allowed as late college student, shall cease to be a candidate.

The M.Ed. programme shall be of two years duration (spread over four semesters) including field attachment for a minimum of 04 weeks and research dissertation. 1. Double Valuation:

An answer script will be evaluated by two independent evaluators

Situation A

- After double valuation, in case of variation between both the scores are up to 19% of the total marks, then average of both the scores will be considered as the final score.
- In case of fractional scores if the fraction is 0.5 or above it is rounded off to the next highest digit and if the fraction is below 0.5 it is rounded off to the lower digit value.

Situation B

- At the end of double valuation, if the variation between two independent scores is 20% and above of the Maximum marks, then such scripts should be considered for Third Valuation. It is to be noted that at least one of the scores among two should be 35% of the maximum marks.

2. Third Valuation:

A third independent evaluator/assessor evaluates such scripts (situation B) and assigns the score.

3. After third valuation:

STEPS FOR DOUBLE AND THIRD VALUATION

1. Double Valuation:

An answer script will be evaluated by two independent evaluators

Situation A

- After double valuation, in case of variation between both the scores are up to 19% of the total marks, then average of both the scores will be considered as the final score.
- In case of fractional scores if the fraction is 0.5 or above it is rounded off to the next highest digit and if the fraction is below 0.5 it is rounded off to the lower digit value.

Situation B

- At the end of double valuation, if the variation between two independent scores is 20% and above of the Maximum marks, then such scripts should be considered for Third Valuation.

It is to be noted that at least one of the scores among two should be 35% of the maximum marks.

2. Third Valuation:

A third independent evaluator/assessor evaluates such scripts (situation B) and assigns the score.

3. After third valuation:

Average of the higher of two scores among all three valuations is considered as the final score.

In case of fractional scores if the fraction is 0.5 or above it is rounded off to the next highest digit and if the fraction is below 0.5 it is rounded off to the lower digit value.

THE NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR INDIAN SYSTEM OF MEDICINE NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 16th February, 2022

F. No. BOA/Regulation/UG/7-10/2021.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 55 of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 (14 of 2020), and in supersession of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Regulation, 1986 except as respects thing done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Commission hereby makes the following regulations, namely:—

Short title and commencement.—(1) These regulations may be called **National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022**

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2 Definitions.—(1) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires,—

- (i) "Act" means the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, Act, 2020 (14 of 2020);
- (ii) "Annexure" means an annexure appended to these regulations;
- (iii) "Appendix" means an appendix appended to these regulations.

(2) The words and expressions used herein and not defined but defined in the Act shall have the same meanings as respectively assigned to them in the Act.

3 Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine And Surgery programme.—The Bachelor of Ayurveda education namely, the Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery (B.A.M.S.) shall produce Graduates, having profound knowledge of Ashtanga Ayurveda along with the contemporary advances in the field of Ayurveda supplemented with knowledge of scientific and technological advances in modern science and technology along with extensive practical training, as an efficient physicians and surgeons for the health care services.

4 Ashtanga Ayurveda.—(a) Ashtanga Ayurveda means eight clinical specialties of ayurveda viz., Kayachikitsa (General/Internal Medicine), Shalya Tantra (Surgery), Shalakya Tantra (Ophthalmology, Oto-Rhino-Laryngology and Oro-Dentistry), Kaumarabhritya (Obstetrics and Paediatrics), Agada Tantra (Clinical Toxicology), Bhuta Vidya (Clinical Microbiology, Clinical Psychology and Psychiatry), Rasayana (Preventive, Promotive, Rejuvenative Medicine and Gerontology) and Vajikarana (Reproductive Medicine and Epigenetics).

(b) All the eight specialties referred to in clause (a) were developed to deal all sort of clinical problems of respective specialty i.e., in general their etiopathogenesis including clinical anatomy, physiology; causative factors in terms of physical, psychological, external (injury, microbes, natural calamities etc.), dietic factors, faulty lifestyles, genetic causes (congenital, hereditary) etc.; clinical manifestation, examination/analysis of biological fluids / secretions/excretions; various diagnostic tools including soopy (naadiyantra), diagnostic criteria, prognostication, principles of management in terms preventive, promotive, curative, palliative and rehabilitative management including surgical; pharmaco-therapeutics as well as pharmaceuticals of related drugs and formulations, relevant therapeutic procedures including physiotherapy techniques such as bandhana, vesthana etc., their methods of administration, complications and management, diet and lifestyle regimen; methods of assessment of improvement/cure, causes of recurrence etc. in relation to that particular clinical condition.

(c) The specialties referred to in clause (a) also deals with instruments/equipment that are required for administration of various therapeutic procedures/surgeries and other procedures, their methods of usage and maintenance. Hospital architecture, landscaping, air-conditioning and human resource management, qualities of nursing staff including ideal patient qualities.

- (v) The examination branch of the institution shall compile the marks of electives obtained by students as specified above and submit to university through the Head of the Institution so that the university shall add the same in viva-voce of respective subjects as shown in *Tables 11, 13 & 15*.
- (i) (i) A candidate obtaining sixty-five per cent. and above marks shall be awarded first class in the subject and seventy-five percent and above marks shall be awarded distinction in the subject.
- (ii) The award of class and distinction shall not be applicable for supplementary examinations.
- (j) (i) Each student shall be required to maintain minimum seventy-five percent attendance in each subject in theory (i.e., lecture hours) practical and clinicals (i.e., non-lecture hours) separately for appearing in examination.
- (ii) Where the institute maintains physical attendance register, it shall be recorded in cumulative numbering method as per *Annexure-iv* and at end of the course/term/ part of the course, after obtaining each student signature the same is to be certified by respective Head of the Department and approved by Head of the Institute.
- (iv) The approved attendance shall be forwarded to university.
- (k) If a student fails to appear in regular examination for cognitive reasons, he may appear in supplementary examination as regular student and his non-appearance in regular examination shall not be treated as an attempt.
- (l) Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations,-
- (i) Clause 11(e) shall be applicable to the student who admitted under Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Regulations, 1986, except electives and as per section 3 of SCHEDULE I (as amended vide notification no. 24-14/2016 (U.G. Regulation) Regulations, 2016) with 4 professionals.
- (ii) Student who got admitted under Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Regulations, 1986, the maximum number of chances and maximum period of years to pass respective professional examination as laid down under the clauses 6(1)(e), 2(e), 3(c), 4(d), and 4(e) of SCHEDULE I (as amended vide notification no. 24-14/2016 (U.G. Regulation) Regulations, 2016) shall not be applicable.

12. Assessment.—Assessment of students shall be in the form of Formative and Summative Assessments as under-

(a) **Formative Assessment.**—Students shall be assessed periodically to assess their performance in the class, determine the understanding of programme material and their learning outcome in the following manner, namely:-

- (i) Periodical Assessment shall be carried out at the end of teaching of a topic or module or a particular portion of syllabus and the evaluation methods as per the following table may be adopted as suits to the content, namely:

(c) **Summative Assessment.**—(i) Final university examinations conducted at the end of each professional B.A.M.S. shall be the Summative Assessment.

(ii) There shall be double valuation system and shall be no provision for revaluation.

(iii) There shall be two examiner (one internal and one external) for university practical/clinical/viva voce examinations.

(iv) While declaring the results of Summative Assessment, Internal Assessment component and Elective marks shall be considered as per the distribution of marks pattern provided in *Tables 11, 13 & 15*.

Postgraduate Diploma in Rehabilitation Psychology (PGDRP)

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The aim of the course is to prepare rehabilitation counselors who promote understanding of the situations and needs of people with disabilities and perform a vital role in the personal, vocational and educational adjustment of persons with disability within self-advocacy and community development model. The program is an ideal model for entry into the field of professional rehabilitation counseling and allows for the easiest avenue to registration under CRR.

The training program prepares prospective candidates in a variety of concepts, theories, and techniques to function in numerous settings such as state or private run rehabilitation centers, public and private schools and other organizations serving persons with physical, sensory or cognitive disabilities. The coursework for the program includes: history of the rehabilitation movement and its legislation, models of disability and rehabilitation theory, psychosocial implications of disabling conditions, theoretical understanding of psychological assessment and testing methods, evaluation of the psychosocial problems and counseling, education and vocational needs of clients, case management skills utilizing community resources and multidisciplinary approach. In summary, the successful trainees have the broad base of rehabilitation knowledge to serve people with disabilities and they also have the ability to counsel, support, and deal with their clients from a humanistic and holistic approach.

1.1 Distinguishing Features

Rehabilitation counseling is first level (entry) of a two-level series within rehabilitation psychology services and is distinguished from the second higher level (M. Phil in Rehabilitation Psychology) training program. The later is an independent full-fledged professional training with higher level of competency, responsibility and authority for providing services to clients with disability. The Rehabilitation Counselor cadre shall not be used as an under fill class for existing Rehabilitation Psychologist positions for providing services to clients with disability.

1.2 Typical Tasks

The successful candidates screen and evaluate referrals to determine potential eligibility for services; may make referrals to other resources as appropriate; assess family background, prior work experience and education, disability, and functional limitations; determine needs and coordinate medical and psychological assessments with concerned specialists and/or medical/psychology consultants; advice/refer for aptitude, intelligence and personality tests and provide interpretation of results to clients and their families; determine physical restoration requirements (e.g., surgery, physical therapy, artificial limbs, hearing aids) and training necessary for employability; coordinate needed services with other agencies and organizations; provide psychological, behavioral, career and vocational counseling to clients; develop and implements rehabilitation plans with each client and track progress through successful termination of the case.

2.0 AIM

The aim of the program is to train candidates in basic knowledge and skills necessary for rehabilitation counseling practice. The program includes core counseling courses (e.g. theories of counseling) and rehabilitation-specific coursework (e.g. assessment of persons with physical/sensory/developmental/ cognitive disability). The program allows the trainees to develop expertise in any one areas of rehabilitation counseling (for eg. school counseling) during the one-month extra-institutional placement, which occurs in the third quarter of the course/training.

2.1 Objectives

On completion of the course the trainees are expected to demonstrate:

- 2.1.1 An understanding of basic physical, sensory, developmental and cognitive impairments and effects such impairments have on functional performance.
- 2.1.2 Knowledge of commonly accepted interventions for various impairments and skill in communicating verbally and in writing the decisions made and explaining and answering questions.
- 2.1.3 Skill in interviewing and providing support and empathy to clients with disability and their families.
- 2.1.4 Ability to utilize the principles and practices used in counseling and in the provision of services to rehabilitation clients and facilitate the development of problem solving skills in individuals with disability.
- 2.1.5 Demonstrate an understanding of caregiver and family burden, suggest and/ or undertake interventions drawing on their knowledge and problem solving skills.
- 2.1.6 Ability to develop plans for vocational rehabilitation clients, and counsel, motivate, and inspire clients.
- 2.1.7 Ability to work within specific agency programs, operations, policies, and procedures affecting assigned work, and to coordinate the provision of services to clients with other agencies and organizations.
- 2.1.8 Ability to read and interpret psychometric reports (intelligence, aptitude, personality assessment etc.) provided by rehabilitation/clinical psychologists and explains the implications of findings to clients and their families and carry out the suggested counseling and/or remedial training with the clients (for eg. remedial training/intervention in children with disorders of scholastic skills, and counseling of families and children with behavioral and emotional disorders occurring in the home/school context)
- 2.1.9 Ability to develop and maintain effective working relationships with local employers and community social service agencies, and market clients' skills and abilities to potential employers.

3.0 INSTITUTIONS ELIGIBLE TO CONDUCT THE COURSE

- 3.1 Centers already recognized by the RCI for conducting M. Phil. Rehabilitation Psychology program are eligible to conduct the course. However, such centers need to apply for Council's permission before starting the course.
- 3.2 Institute/center catering to people with following disability are eligible to conduct the program.
- A) Specific developmental disability such as mental retardation, cerebral palsy, autism spectrum disorders, epilepsy or any disabling conditions found to be closely related to development processes, that limits/disrupt life activities such as learning, speech and language, mobility, self-help, and independent living begin anytime during developmental period (up to 18 years of age), and lasting throughout a person's lifetime.
 - B) Locomotor disability-congenital or acquired, including leprosy-cured.
 - C) Sensory impairments such as hearing or vision and both.
 - D) Multiple disabilities.
 - E) Traumatic/burn injuries.
 - F) Postgraduate Department of Psychology at universities having attachment or an MOU with any of the Rehabilitation centers (specified in A to E) to place the trainees for hands-on experience
- 3.3 There shall be at least two regular rehabilitation/clinical psychology faculty members on fulltime basis at the center, one of them with at least 5 years of post-qualification (RCI recognized M.Phil. Rehabilitation Psychology or Clinical Psychology degree) experience.

4.0 REGULATIONS OF THE COURSE

4.1 Number of Seats

Since the course involves hands-on training, the number of candidates registered for the course will depend on the availability of qualified clinical psychology/ rehabilitation psychology faculty working fulltime in the concerned institute and the clinical material available at the center. In order to make the training effective, therefore, the intake of the students shall not exceed the following ratio.

RCI Registered Rehabilitation/Clinical Psychologist working fulltime on regular basis -
Candidate ratio shall be, 1: 5

4.2 Entry requirement

Minimum educational requirement for admission to this course will be

- a. Bachelor's degree (regular mode) with general psychology courses in all the three years, or
- b. Master's degree in any branch of psychology either in regular or distance mode, or
- c. Master's degree in counseling psychology either in regular or distance mode.

with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate. For SC/ST/OBC category, minimum of 50% marks in aggregate is essential. Entry qualification shall be from a UGC recognized university.

4.3 Admission Procedure

A selection committee constituted by the University/ Institute shall make admission on the basis of aggregate percentage of marks, academic achievements and experience, if any, in the field of rehabilitation.

4.4 Duration

4.4.1 This is a fulltime training course with opportunities for appropriate practicum and supervised experiences for one academic year.

4.4.2 The candidates shall be posted at any other specialty center for a period of one-month duration during the third quarter of the training.

4.5 Attendance

4.5.1 Course of training must continuously be pursued and complete all the course requirements within a stipulated period from the date of enrollment.

4.5.2 A minimum attendance of 80% shall be necessary for appearing for qualifying examination.

4.5.3 Fifteen days leave shall be permitted during the entire course period.

4.6 Fee Structure

The prescribed tuition and examination fee as laid down from time to time by the concerned institution shall be paid by the candidates.

4.7 Content of the Course (See section 5.0 for subject wise syllabus.)

Group – A

- Paper I : Disability and Rehabilitation
Paper II : Psychosocial Issues in Disability
Paper III : Rehabilitation Assessment and counseling
Papers IV : Community Based Rehabilitation
Practical : Rehabilitation Interventions and viva voce

Group – B

Submission : Five fully worked-out Rehabilitation Counseling Records which include case formulation, problem areas elicited, type and technique/s employed to resolve the problems, and the processes of counseling. Out of five records, two shall be related child cases including one from multiple disabilities.

4.8 Minimum prescribed clinical work during the training.

4.9 Internal Assessment

In each subjects of Group – A, 30% marks shall be determined on the basis of two internal exams (theory and practical), each conducted for 50 marks. The marks so obtained are added to the marks allocated to the respective subjects in the final examinations. The results of the final examinations will be declared on the basis of the total so obtained.

4.10 Examination

- a) Before appearing for the qualifying examination a candidate should have done the minimum prescribed clinical work as outlined in section 4.8. The logbook duly certified by the concerned supervisors shall be submitted at the time of examination for an evaluation of the clinical work done by the board of examiners.
- b) A candidate failing in any of the Group – A subjects has to appear again in all the Group – A subjects.
- c) A candidate failing in Group – B has to resubmit five fully worked-out counseling records.
- d) A candidate shall appear for both Group A and B examinations when appearing for the first time.
- e) All candidates have to complete the course successfully within a period of three years from the year of admission to course, and within three attempts.
- f) The qualifying examination is held twice a year. The dates for supplementary examinations shall be worked out by the concerned universities depending upon the start of the academic year.
- g) The medium of instruction and examination shall be in English.

4.12 Board of Examination

The University will conduct the examinations having a board consisting of two examiners of which one shall be an external Rehabilitation/Clinical Psychology faculty appointed for this purpose, and the other shall be an internal Rehabilitation/Clinical Psychology faculty. Both internal and external examiners shall evaluate each theory paper and conduct the practical including viva-voce examination.

4.13 Minimum for Pass

No candidate shall be declared to have passed the course unless he/she obtains not less than 50% of the marks in:

- i) Each of the theory paper (Group – A)
- ii) Practical and viva-voce examination (Group – A)
- iii) Submission (Group – B)

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5.0 SUBJECT WISE SYLLABUS

The syllabus for each theory paper is as appended below. It is desired that each units of papers be covered with at least 4-hr. of input in the form of didactic lectures, seminars, tutorials/topic discussion as deemed fit depending on content nature of the units. Approximately 80-hr of theory teaching shall be required in the entire course (in all 20 units have been worked out from four theory papers), in addition to opportunities for learning through rehabilitation case management and work-ups.

6.0 CERTIFICATION AS A REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL

It is mandatory as per Section 13 of RCI Act for every teacher of special education to obtain a "Registered Professional Certificate" from the Rehabilitation Council of India to work in field of professional rehabilitation counseling in India. As continuous professional growth is necessary for the renewal of the certificate, the **Rehabilitation Counselors** should undergo in-service programme periodically to update their professional knowledge.

Amendments, if any, to the regulations of the course will be made periodically by the Rehabilitation Council of India. Any deviation from the above regulations should have the prior approval of the Rehabilitation Council of India. The successful students will be registered as **Rehabilitation Counselors (Professional)**. The training institution/organization should ensure that all passed out students are registered with the Council.

- Unit III: Disability and Rehabilitation – Models of disability and rehabilitation, enabling-disabling processes, impact of the physical, social and psychological environments on the enabling-disabling processes, effects of disability on participation, psychosocial theories of adjustment, strategies to enhance adjustment, functional limitations and strategies to reduce and accommodate limitations
- Unit IV: Disability through life-cycle – Specific problems pertaining to each stage of life - childhood, adolescence, young adulthood, middle age, and older adulthood, and adapting strategies
- Unit V: Ethics and policy issues – Rehabilitation ethics, rehabilitation policies and Acts(Persons with Disabilities Act, The National Trust Act, Mental Health Care Act, Rehabilitation Council of India Act, UNCRPD), assistance, concessions, social benefits and support from government, and voluntary organizations; contemporary challenges, civil rights and legislation, empowerment issues

- Unit III: Family issues – Relationship issues with family, problems of families of disabled adults and children, impact of disability on family, family burden, needs of family and models of family adaptation, intervention to strengthening family support to disabled
- Unit IV: Social issues – Societal attitudes toward disabilities, measurement of attitude and strategies for attitude change, social environment, social participation, social interaction, social network and support, disabling factors, prejudice, stigma, discrimination, marginalization, gender disparity
- Unit V: Vocational issues - Career competency, career development issues, work related stress, economic independence, well-being, assistive devices for activities of daily living, mobility aids, at work place, sensory devices, environment modifications and universal designs, needed support system
