NOTICE

In view of the COVID-19 pandemic scenario it is not feasible to conduct the proposed Entrance Test for admission to BBA and BCA courses in UCBS Avalodge for the academic session 2020-2021 and the admission to these courses will be made on the basis of merit in the qualifying examination i.e. 10+2. The criterion for admission approved by University Authorities is as under:

1. Criteria for admission to BBA Course (Subsidized Seats)

- i). Merit will be drawn on the basis of marks obtained in 10+2 examinations.
- ii) While computing the merit of BBA course a candidate having Commerce or Mathematics as a subject at 10+2 level will be given additional weightage of 10% of the percentage of aggregate marks obtained by him/her in 10+2 examinations.

2. Criteria for admission to BCA Course (Subsidized Seats)

- i) Merit will be drawn on the basis of marks obtained in 10+2 examinations.

3. Non-Subsidized Seats(BBA and BCA): For non subsidized seats admission shall be based on the percentage of marks scored in 10+2 examination only. The candidates on merit depending upon the number of seats shall be admitted to the course and there will not be any kind of reservation.

To resolve a tie, students having more marks in the matriculation will be given preference. However, if marks in matriculation are also equal, and then junior in age will be admitted.



4. Category Certificate (SC, ST, Physically Challenged, Sports, Cultural, Single Girl Child etc. if applicable)
5. Character Certificate

Admission of the candidates will be subject to verification of original documents in UCBS after the college will open for students as and when situation will improve and notified by the authorities.

This criterion will be applicable for the session 2020-2021 only.
