in Charu Khurana & Ors. V. UOI, 2018 by observing that “Though there has been formal removal of institutionalized discrimination on gender basis yet mindset and attitude grounded in subconscious have not been erased”.

Keeping these facts and issues in mind an attempt shall be made to bring the academicians, scholars, advocates, judges and researchers from different backgrounds at one platform to share various aspects of feministic jurisprudence. Participation from diverse groups of people and discussions will open new vistas which may be useful in making system free from gender biasness.
