1. Project Fellow – 02 Posts (27,000 per month consolidated for a period of eighteen months)

Essential Qualification

- Ph.D. / pursuing Ph.D. in Environmental Sciences / Life Sciences.
- Field experience in relevant areas.
- Awareness and understanding of the customs, rituals and social structure of the tribal communities of Himachal Pradesh.

Nature of Work: The selected candidates will assist in field surveys, collection and documentation of information on ethnomedicine and folk healing practices, interaction with community members, field documentation, data compilation and other activities related to the project.

2. Office Assistant – 02 Posts (20,000 per month consolidated for a period of one year)

Essential Qualification / Skills

- Knowledge of typing and computer operations.
- Knowledge of accounts-related work.
- Ability to maintain official records and handle files.
- Relevant experience in office, accounts, record management or related work will be preferred.

Nature of Work: The selected candidates will assist in typing, data entry, maintenance of official records, handling of files, accounts-related work and other administrative activities of the project.

2. Candidates must bring their original certificates/documents along with one set of self-attested photocopies at the time of the interview.
