Counselling for admission to Ph.D. (Journalism and Mass Communication)

The counselling for admission to Ph.D. in Journalism and Mass Communication will be held on 20th July 2016 in the office of the undersigned from 10.00 am to 2.00 pm. All candidates (in the list enclosed) are advised to:

- i. Mark their attendance in person at the counseling venue between 10.00 to 11.00 am on the date of counseling;
- ii. Present all their testimonials (along with identification proof) in original for verification;
- iii. Submit admission fee of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) on the spot in case of your selection. In case the fee is not submitted on the date of counseling, the seat will be considered as vacant and shall be offered to the next candidate in the merit list;
- iv. The merit list (drawn as per documents submitted by each candidate) is enclosed herewith. A candidate may represent to the undersigned (in writing with valid proof) before the date of counseling for correcting any mistake. The corrected list will be displayed on the Department Notice Board.

Along with above,

- i. Candidates who have submitted their CGPA/SGPA or like scores are advised to present a valid Statement of Marks (for calculation of percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying examination i.e. Master of Mass Communication, MA (Journalism and Mass Communication), or equivalent);
- ii. Candidates who cannot present the above document are advised to present a formula for conversion of grade points to the exact percentage of marks (verified from their respective Universities);
- iii. Candidates seeking exemption from course work are required to present a proof of admission to M.Phil./Ph.D. course work through entrance test;
- iv. In-service candidates are required to submit a NOC from their respective employers.

It may be also be noted that

- i. No TA/DA shall be paid for attending the counseling.
- ii. The candidates have been invited to attend the counseling in the ratio of 1:3 (i.e. three times the number of available seats). The invitation to attend counseling does mean a right to admission to the course.
- iii. The admissions will be made strictly on the basis of merit in the qualifying examination;
- iv. Additional observations in the enclosed list may be attended to by the respective candidates.
